

#81 The Daniel 2:41-43 Feet of Iron and Clay

Key Understanding: *The Feet and Toes, part of clay, part of iron, in Daniel 2:41-43, indicate division. Just as we saw the theme of division with the Legs of Iron of the Roman Empire, we also see that same theme of division extended to the Feet and Toes of Daniel 2:41-43. In fact, there is a theme of division in each verse – in Daniel 2:41, Daniel 2:42, and Daniel 2:43 – with IRON vs. CLAY also used to show the division.*

(i) Division in Daniel 2:41 is seen through **THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED.**

*Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest **THE FEET AND TOES, part of potters' CLAY, and part of IRON, THE KINGDOM SHALL BE DIVIDED**; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.*

(ii) Division in Daniel 2:42 is seen through **THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG, and PARTLY BROKEN.**

*Daniel 2:42 (KJV) And as the **TOES OF THE FEET** were part of **IRON**, and part of **CLAY**, so **THE KINGDOM SHALL BE PARTLY STRONG, and PARTLY BROKEN.***

(iii) Division in Daniel 2:43 is seen through **THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER.**

*Daniel 2:43 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest **IRON** mixed with miry **CLAY**, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but **THEY SHALL NOT CLEAVE ONE TO ANOTHER,** even as **IRON** is not mixed with **CLAY**.*
