

#179 Making the World Safe for Democracy – Dedicating Lives and Fortunes: The concluding part of the April 2, 1917, War Message drew together Washington’s Revolutionary War and Wilson’s World War I

(a) The concluding part of the *Declaration of Independence* reads:

And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, **we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes,** and our sacred honor.

(b) The concluding part of Woodrow Wilson’s War Message of April 2, 1917, draws from the concluding part of the *Declaration of Independence*:

Wilson concluded his war message, “But the right is more precious than peace, and we shall fight for the things which we have always carried nearest our hearts -- for democracy, for the right of those who submit to authority to have a voice in their own governments, for the rights and liberties of small nations, for a universal dominion of right by such a concert of free peoples as shall bring PEACE AND SAFETY to all nations and make the world itself at last free. To such a task we can dedicate our lives and our fortunes, everything that we are and everything that we have, with the pride of those who know that the day has come when America is privileged to spend her blood and her might for the principles that gave her birth and happiness and the peace which she has treasured. God helping her, she can do no other.”

Key Understanding: *The Revolutionary War and World War I.* The conclusion of Woodrow Wilson’s April 2, 1917, War Message to Congress drew directly from the *Declaration of Independence* and the Revolutionary War, thus drawing together the pair of (a) George Washington’s Revolutionary War, the First Ascension of America, and (b) Woodrow Wilson’s World War I, the *Second Ascension of America*.

The First and *Second* Ascensions of America were also tied to America fulfilling its position as the *Fourth* Rome. **George Washington** was born at **Popes Creek**. **Woodrow Wilson** married a **Rome woman**.

Remember, World War I was birthing both the 7th Kingdom USSR, and the *Second* Ascension of the 8th Kingdom U.S. . . .

*Revelation 17:10-11 (KJV) . . . and **THE OTHER** [the Seventh Kingdom, the USSR] **IS NOT YET COME**; and when he cometh, he [the Seventh Kingdom, the USSR] must continue **A SHORT SPACE**.*

*11 And **THE BEAST** [out of the Pit in Rev. 17:08, the United States of America] that was, and is not, even **HE IS THE EIGHTH**, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.*
