

#217 The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 – The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 and the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1

In Unsealings [#205–#216](#), we discussed The Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7, in the Old Testament. Now we are ready to discuss **The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1**, in the New Testament. First, Daniel 7:7 and then Revelation 13:1-2.

*Daniel 7:7 (KJV) After this I saw in the night visions, and **BEHOLD A FOURTH BEAST [Roman Empire]**, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and **IT HAD TEN HORNS**.*



*Revelation 13:1-2 (KJV) And I stood upon the sand of the sea[shore], and saw **A BEAST RISE UP OUT OF THE SEA, HAVING SEVEN HEADS AND TEN HORNS**, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.
2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.*

Key Understanding: The ten horns. At first glance – because the passages are so similar – one might think that the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1 are identical to the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7. They are not.

To learn why the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 are *not* the same as the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1, let's first focus on the *similarities* of the two passages, before we understand the *differences* between the Ten Horns of Daniel 7:7 and the Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1.
