

#262 The Austrian Successor – The Wars (plural) of Austrian Succession

We can now see a number of wars preparing and establishing America as the Austrian Successor at either its Revolutionary War *First* Ascension birth, or its World War I *Second* Ascension.

These wars can be called Wars of the Austrian Succession because they led up to and included the Revolutionary War *First* Ascension birth of the United States:

- (1) War of the Austrian Succession (1740-1748)
- (2) French and Indian War (1754-1763) / Seven Years' War (1756-1763)
- (3) Revolutionary War (1775-1783)

This war can be called a War of the Austrian Succession because it led to the death of the Austrian Empire and the *Second* Ascension of the United States:

- (4) World War I (1914-1918)

Key Understanding: *The wars (plural) of Austrian Succession. The War of the Austrian Succession (1740-1748), the French and Indian War (1754-1763)/Seven Years' War (1756-1763), the Revolutionary War (1775-1783), and World War I (1914-1918) can all be called Wars of the Austrian Succession, as they prepared America to be the Austrian Successor at either its Revolutionary War *First* Ascension birth, or its World War I *Second* Ascension.*

[The Ten Horns with Ten Crowns are fulfilled through the Bill of Rights of December 15, 1791, 29 years *less 2 months* after the February 15, 1763, Treaty of Hubertusburg ended the Seven Years' War.]
