

#283 St. Petersburg, the City of Three Names – The St. Petersburg Sword for Christian Autocracy was a counterfeit of the Revelation 19:15 Sword and Rod of Iron rule of Jesus Christ

Let's recall the unveilings associated with Unsealing #62 The Legs of Iron – The Legs of Iron vs. the Rod of Iron.

A part of that picture was the Russian Orthodox Christian Empire, a so-called Christian Empire that constituted a Leg of Iron of the Roman Empire, but in the process also represented a counterfeit millennial reign of Jesus Christ, who comes to rule with a Rod of Iron (Rev. 19:15).

Now let's think about all of that in terms of St. Peter and his Sword, represented by the Russian Empire's St. Petersburg Sword of Christian Autocracy.

Key Understanding: *The Lord chose St. Petersburg to represent the sword of Christian autocracy. To make the point about true Christianity vs. false Christianity, and the Cross vs. the Sword – which was the issue of St. Peter as he drew the Sword to keep Jesus Christ from going to the Cross – the Lord chose St. Petersburg, a city named after St. Peter, to represent the Sword of Christian Autocracy as a counterfeit of the Revelation 19:15 Sword and Rod of Iron rule of Jesus Christ.*

Revelation 19:14-15 (KJV) And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15 AND OUT OF HIS MOUTH GOETH A SHARP SWORD, that with it he should smite the nations: and HE [Jesus Christ] SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

In short, the Lord attached to the Russian Empire the Sword of St. Peter – representing false Christianity – as a Rod of Iron counterfeit of Jesus Christ's Sword and Rod of Iron Rule of Revelation 19:15.

John 13:37-38: Peter would draw the Sword for Jesus, but not go to the Cross for Jesus

*John 13:37-38 (KJV) Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? **I will lay down my life for thy sake.***

*38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **THE COCK SHALL NOT CROW, TILL THOU HAST DENIED ME THRICE.***

But, after the demise of the Russian Empire's St. Peter's Sword (St. Petersburg Sword) for Christian *Autocracy* would come St. Peter's Sword (St. Petersburg Sword) for Christian *Democracy*, initiating St. Petersburg's soon-fulfilled destiny as the "City of Three Names."
