


#302 The Image of the Beast – In summary, both the United States Beast and the United Nations Image of the Beast have the foundational spirit of “World Peace through Democracy”

Key Understanding: *Both the United States beast and the United Nations image of the beast have the foundational spirit of “world peace through democracy.”* Just as the Beast since World War I has had the *unofficial* doctrine of “Peace through Democracy,” the ‘Image of the Beast’ United Nations – since the time of its inception at the end of World War II – has had *official* goals and purposes of bringing “Peace” and “Rights” to the world, with the specific understanding that “Self-determination” (democracy) for the peoples of the world can bring Universal Peace. It is the counterfeit of Isaiah 2:4.


Isaiah 2:4 (KJV) And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: *and THEY SHALL BEAT THEIR SWORDS INTO PLOWSHARES, and their spears into pruninghooks: NATION SHALL NOT LIFT UP SWORD AGAINST NATION, NEITHER SHALL THEY LEARN WAR ANY MORE.*



Very Important Point:

The United Nations began developing in earnest during World War II when the Allies against Hitler’s Third Reich were often referred to as the “united nations” (*left and right*). These “united nations” included both the United States and the Soviet Union. Thus, when the United Nations was formed on its agreed upon “self-determination” principles,

it was rendered ineffective because of the ensuing Cold War that split the world and the members of the United Nations. However, as the Soviet Union was weakening during 1989-1991 – heading to its December 1991 demise – there finally became a more genuine unity within the United Nations. Nations joined together and were led by the United States against a Saddam Hussein-led Iraq in the 1991 Gulf War.



What is described in the paragraph above is a quite enormous part of prophecy that we must cover in more detail later.
