


#410 The Men Named Lennon and Lenin – Daniel 12:8: What shall be the end of these things? The December 8, 1980, End of Lennon forecast the December 8, 1991, End of Soviet Leninism

Key Understanding: *The end of Lennon and the end of Leninism.* The reason why The End of a Man Named Lennon and The End of Soviet Leninism occurred on 12/8/1980 and 12/8/1991, respectively, is because they were a sign of and a part of the fulfillment of Daniel 12:8, “What shall be The End of these things?”, which surrounds the Man Clothed in Linen in Daniel 12:6-7. Moreover, the death of John Lennon was actually forecasting and pointing to the death of Lenin’s Soviet Union.



Down the road we will explain more thoroughly why all of the above is so, and the fuller and deeper meaning of the passage of Daniel 12:4-9.

Daniel 12:4-9 (KJV) But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to THE TIME OF THE END: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

5 Then I Daniel looked, and, behold, there stood other two, the one on this side of the bank of the river, and the other on that side of the bank of the river.

6 And one said to THE MAN CLOTHED IN LINEN, which was upon the waters of the river, How long shall it be to the end of these wonders?

7 And I heard THE MAN CLOTHED IN LINEN, which was upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and swore by him that liveth for ever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished.

8 And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, WHAT SHALL BE THE END OF THESE THINGS? [The end of John Lennon occurred on 12/8/1980, and the end of Soviet Leninism occurred 11 years later on 12/8/1991.]

9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till THE TIME OF THE END.
