


#412 The Men Named Lennon and Lenin – An 11-year spread (April 22, 1870 – April 22, 1881) tied to Lenin’s *birth*/Lenin’s *birth* of the USSR; an 11-year spread (December 8, 1980 – December 8, 1991) tied to the *death* of Lenin’s USSR

In the course of examining the Double Russian Revolutions of 1917 (Unsealings #190–#193), there was discussion of the two births in Simbirsk, Russia, on the Volga River (Unsealing #192). The two opposing leaders of the Double Russian Revolutions of 1917 were Alexander Kerensky, representing the democratic Provisional Government, and V. I. Lenin, representing the Bolshevik Revolution. The doubles that surrounded these two were:

- Lenin and Kerensky were both born on April 22, 11 years apart. **Lenin was born on April 22, 1870. Kerensky was born on April 22, 1881.**
- Lenin and Kerensky were both born in Simbirsk (renamed Ulyanovsk), Russia, which lies on the Volga River.
- Lenin’s and Kerensky’s fathers were both educational administrators.
- Lenin and Kerensky led their respective Russian revolutions.

	<p>Key Understanding: There was an exact 11-year spread (April 22, 1870 – April 22, 1881) between the respective <i>births</i> of Lenin (<i>left</i>) and Kerensky (<i>right</i>), the leaders of the Double Russian Revolutions that <i>birthed</i> the USSR.</p>	
	<p>Then, there was an exact 11-year spread (December 8, 1980 – December 8, 1991) from the <i>death</i> of ‘Imagine there’s no heaven’ John Lennon to the <i>death</i> of V. I. Lenin’s ‘Imagine there’s no heaven’ USSR.</p>

9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till THE TIME OF THE END.
