

#456 Thomas Paine and God Trying Men's Souls – The ordained irony of *These are the times that try men's souls*

Daniel 12:10 (KJV) MANY SHALL BE PURIFIED, and MADE WHITE [in the counterfeit, White Russia's parliament on December 10, 1991, approved the December 8, 1991, agreement to end the Soviet Union and create the Commonwealth of Independent States], ***and TRIED*** [in the counterfeit, reference the “at the beginning” Revolutionary War's Thomas Paine and *These are the times that TRY men's souls*]; ***but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.***

Thomas Paine's version of *These are the times that try men's souls* is the Lord's way of revealing the counterfeit of the true heavenly kingdom battle for souls.

The trying of men's souls was taking place through the offering of a new kingdom of this world and its glory, the United States of America. It was a trying of men's souls that had its roots in Satan's temptation of Jesus Christ in Matthew 4:8-9.



Matthew 4:8-11 (KJV) Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, AND SHEWETH HIM ALL THE KINGDOMS OF THE

WORLD, AND THE GLORY OF THEM;

9 And saith unto him, ALL THESE THINGS WILL I GIVE THEE, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.
