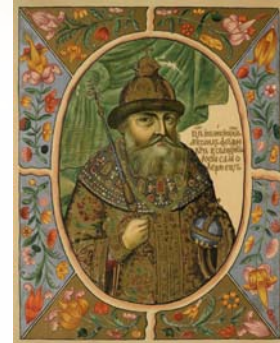


#529 The Rise of Michael the Archangel – From Boris and Mikhail to Mikhail and Boris

- (1) The first Time of Troubles featured **Boris** and **Mikhail**.



Boris Godunov (pictured left) was Tsar of Russia (1598-1605) and was associated with the *beginning* of the first Time of Troubles. **Mikhail Feodorovich Romanov** (pictured right) was Tsar of Russia (1613-1645) and ended the first Time of Troubles.



- (2) The second Time of Troubles involved **Mikhail**.

Pseudo-Tsar **Mikhail Alexandrovich Romanov** was a part of the story – especially a part of the *prophetic* story – of the second Time of Troubles during the time period of the Russian Revolutions (1917) and the Russian Civil War (1918-1920).

- (3) The third Time of Troubles featured **Mikhail** and **Boris**.

While Boris preceded Mikhail in the first Time of Troubles, **Mikhail Gorbachev** (right in the picture) would precede **Boris Yeltsin** (left in the picture) in the third Time of Troubles. **Mikhail Gorbachev** led the Soviet Union (1985-1991), and **Boris Yeltsin** was President of Russia (1991-1999).



Key Understanding: Mikhail and Boris. Just as the first Time of Troubles featured a **Boris and a **Mikhail**, the “time of the end” fall of the Soviet Union also featured a **Mikhail** and a **Boris**, leading many in Russia to easily label the time period of great instability after the 1991 fall of the Soviet Union as the third Time of Troubles in Russia’s history.**
