

## #654 The Cotton Saints vs. the Linen Saints – The 1914 White Armies, part 1, The 1914 White Army of the Third Rome Tsar

Note that the Revelation 19:14 armies could be called White Armies, or even White Linen Armies, since they are clothed in fine *linen*, *white* and clean.

**Revelation 19:14-15 (KJV) And THE ARMIES WHICH WERE IN HEAVEN FOLLOWED HIM UPON WHITE HORSES, CLOTHED IN FINE LINEN, WHITE AND CLEAN.**

*15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.*



The background for this Unsealing of **The 1914 White Armies** is the earlier series of Red Armies vs. White Armies in Unsealings [#489](#)–[#496](#). The Russian Civil War that was a contest between who were called the *Reds* and the *Whites*, or the *Red Army* vs. the *White Army*, occurred in the years 1918-1920. It was won by the Lenin and Trotsky-led Bolshevik Reds, enabling them to establish the Soviet Union. Many people were made red. Later, when the Red Soviet Union fell in 1991, many were made white, fulfilling Daniel 12:10.



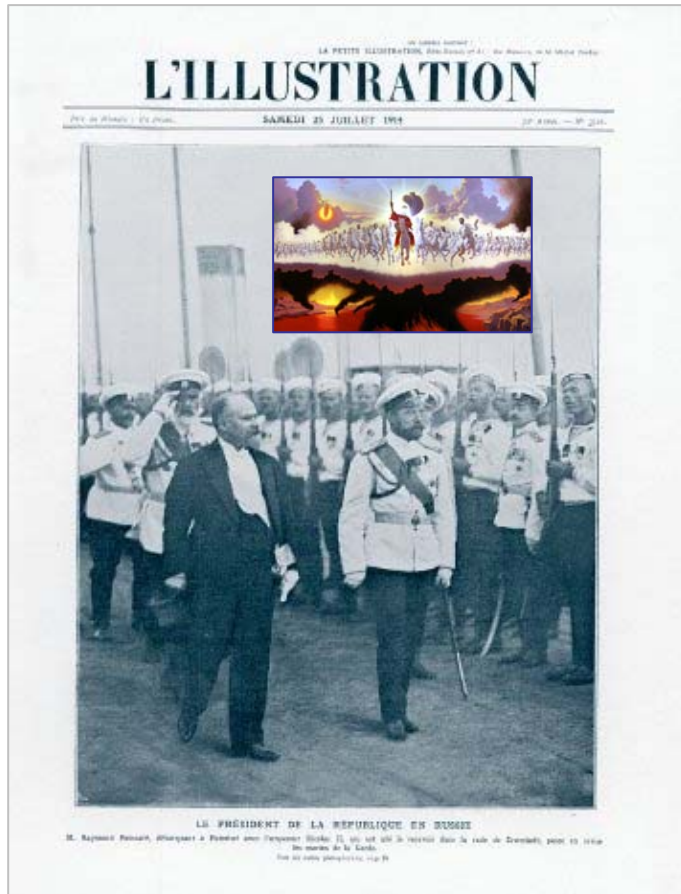
***Daniel 12:10 (KJV) MANY SHALL BE PURIFIED, and MADE WHITE, and TRIED; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.***

**Russian Tsar Nicholas II's 1914 White Army.** Initially, before Tsar Nicholas II was executed with his family during the summer of 1918, a portion of those who were a part of the disjointed White Army during the Russian Civil war of 1918-1920 were those who supported the reinstatement of the Tsar to his throne. The prophetic point is that . . .

**Key Understanding: Tsar Nicholas II and the 1914 white linen army.** The Tsar Nicholas II-led Russian army of 1914 at the beginning of World War I should be looked upon as the prototype 1914 White Linen Army because (a) it started on the side of who became the

eventual ‘Make the World Safe for Democracy’ victorious Allies in World War I, whom history looks back on as being “of God,” and because (b) its remnants that participated as part of the *White Army* during the Russian Civil War of 1918-1920 are to be contrasted with the *Red Lenin Army* of V. I. Lenin and Leon Trotsky.

In short, one is to see the contrast between the 1914 *White Linen Army* of the Third Rome Tsar and the 1918-1920 *Red Lenin Army* of V. I. Lenin.
