

#728 The Double Eight (88) Kingdoms of England and America – The Lord uses *double eight*, or 88, to point to the building of America as the Protestant Beast, the *Eighth* Kingdom, out of the Pit of England – 88 years after 1688 – and to incorporate the initial phase of Protestant England ‘rising’ out of the Pit of the Netherlands

The title says it all.

Key Understanding #1: ‘88’s represent the double of England and America rising out of the pit. The Lord uses *double eight*, or 88, to point to the building of America as the Protestant Beast, the *Eighth* Kingdom, out of the Pit of England, and to incorporate the initial phase of Protestant England ‘rising’ out of the Pit of the Netherlands, particularly through the double Protestant Wind events of ‘88 (1588) and ‘88 (1688).

Key Understanding #2: *Why there were 88 years between 1688 and 1776. The Glorious Revolution of 1688 in England represented England arising out of the Pit of the Netherlands, and 88 years later, the ‘glorious revolution’ of 1776 in America represented America arising out of the Pit of England.*



Revelation 17:08 (KJV) THE BEAST [America, the Eighth (8th) Kingdom, Revelation 17:11] that thou sawest was, and is not; and SHALL ASCEND OUT OF THE BOTTOMLESS PIT [having *historical roots* in the combination of *England-Netherlands*, but also having the *spiritual roots* that came with those historical roots. Those *spiritual roots* were not from God,

but were from the *spiritual abyss*, the *spiritual pit*, the *spiritual netherworld*. **America's ascension as the 8th Kingdom included the initial phase of Protestant England 'rising' out of the Netherlands, represented through the defeat of the Spanish Armada in '88 (1588) and the successful invasion of the Dutch Armada in '88 (1688)], and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.**
