

#790 The Red Horse Rider – Red Armies vs. White Armies

Key Understanding: Our previous coverage of Red Armies vs. White Armies in Unsealings [#489](#)–[#496](#) simply adds to the understanding of the rise of the White Horse Rider in World War I and the rise of the Red Horse Rider in World War I.

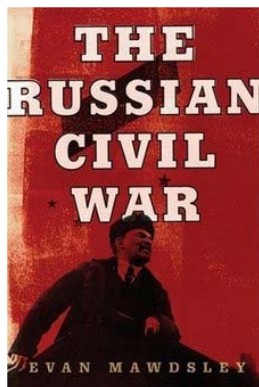
In short, the Russian Civil War, a reflection of the position of the U.S. vs. the Red Bolsheviks near the end of World War I, was a war between the Reds and Whites, and ended with the *rise* of the Soviet Union. Many were made *red*. With the December 8-10, 1991, *fall* of the Soviet Union, many were made *white*.

To refresh our memories, a key verse in Red Armies vs. White Armies was Daniel 12:10.



Daniel 12:10 (KJV) MANY SHALL BE PURIFIED, and MADE WHITE [in the counterfeit, White Russia's parliament on December 10, 1991, approved the December 8, 1991, agreement to end the Soviet Union and create the Commonwealth of Independent States], and TRIED [in the counterfeit, referring back to Thomas Paine and *These are the times that TRY men's souls*, also seen in Revelation 3:10 in the letter to the Church in Philadelphia]; ***but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.***
