

#875 The Mother of Harlots – The Birth of Churchill’s Mother was chosen by the Lord to represent the Republican Party as a layer of fulfillment of the Mother of Harlots

In Unsealings [#836](#) and [#852](#), we addressed the birth of Winston Churchill’s American mother, Jennie Jerome, occurring on January 9, 1854, 2 months + 11 days before the March 20, 1854, birth of the Republican Party in the United States. The question might arise as to why the Lord – in his ordainment of connecting *Churchill* with the *Republican Party* – would choose the birth of Churchill’s *mother*, instead of the birth of Winston Churchill himself, for example, to represent such a thing.

Key Understanding: Mothers of harlots. The Lord ordained the January 9, 1854, birth of Winston Churchill’s mother, Jennie Jerome, to correlate with the March 20, 1854, birth of the Republican Party of Babylon the Great, to show that while America-Babylon the Great has its own mostly-Protestant Reformation-based role as the Mother of Harlots, the Republican Party itself within Babylon the Great has its own role as “the Mother of Harlots” of the Church-ill saints.
