

#903 The Second Babel's One Language and One Speech – Thomas Jefferson helps to fulfill “These have *one mind*” through “I have sworn upon the altar of God eternal hostility against every form of tyranny over *the mind of man*”

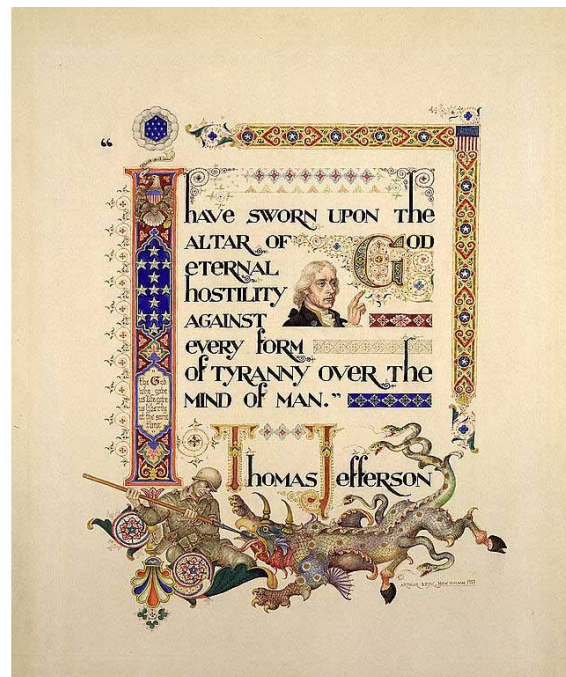


Thomas Jefferson. Few are exalted more than the author of the U.S. Declaration of Independence, Thomas Jefferson. For his extraordinary life and works and vast impact on the human race, Jefferson was labeled by many as “the man of the millennium,” referring to the millennium from 1000 A.D. to 2000 A.D. President John F. Kennedy welcomed forty-nine Nobel Prize winners to the White House in 1962, saying, “I think this is the most extraordinary collection of talent and of human knowledge

that has ever been gathered together at the White House – with the possible exception of when Thomas Jefferson dined alone.”

Fighting tyranny over the mind of man. It is this statement attributed to Jefferson and inscribed upon marble (at Jefferson’s head level in the picture *below left*) at the Jefferson Memorial in Washington D.C. that the Lord would like to draw our attention to:

“I have sworn upon the altar of God eternal hostility against every form of tyranny over the mind of man.”



The minds of men exalt Jefferson’s statement about “the mind of man.” Remember, the doctrines of Thomas Jefferson’s *Declaration of Independence* come from the Age of Reason/Age of Enlightenment. [Reference Unsealing [#271](#) The Cross of Jesus Christ vs. the Rights of Man – Thomas Jefferson’s false doctrine of “God-given unalienable rights,” as well as Unsealings [#389](#) and [#449–#451](#).] For those of the Age of Reason and Age of Enlightenment, it stands to reason that God’s great purpose is for man to win the war between Tyranny and the Rights of Man, and for every man, like Thomas Jefferson, to be eternally hostile toward “every form of tyranny over the mind of man.” However, it can be seen that . . .

Key Understanding: Jefferson’s eternal hostility. In ironic fashion, the Lord ordained Thomas Jefferson to help fulfill “these have one mind” in Revelation 17:13 through Jefferson’s proclamation, “I have sworn upon the altar of God eternal hostility against every form of tyranny over the mind of man.” The defeats of the Triple 7th Kingdoms of Great Britain (Revolutionary War), Germany (World War II), and the USSR (Cold War) by the United States represent victories over “every form of tyranny over the mind of man,” fulfilling “these have one mind” through bringing the world into *one mind* regarding the Rights of Man and Making the World Safe for Democracy.

Revelation 17:11-13 (KJV) And THE BEAST that was, and is not, even he IS THE EIGHTH, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

12 And the TEN HORNS [Bill of Rights] which thou sawest are TEN KINGS, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

13 THESE [the crowned U.S. Bill of Rights, representing “the people”] HAVE ONE MIND [one purpose, surrounding Thomas Jefferson’s proclamation, “I have sworn upon the altar of God eternal hostility against every form of tyranny over the mind of man”], and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. [We the People, represented by the Bill of Rights, give their power – “people power” – to the Beast, America. They are of “one language” and “one speech,” to Make the World Safe for Democracy.]
