

#913 The Woman is that Great City Babylon, II – From (a) the ‘single democratic nation Second Babel’ U.S. Constitution of September 17, 1787, to (b) ‘the Woman and worldwide Second Babel’ and the U.S. Constitution’s 19th Amendment on August 26, 1920

The two steps. In Unsealing #891, it was discussed that the Lord intends for us to see *two steps* in the attempt to build a *worldwide* Second Babel of Genesis 11. There is the *first step* of building *a single democratic nation* as a Second Babel, and that was through Benjamin Franklin/James Wilson and the Founding Fathers uniting the former colonies into “united states” of the United States. Then came the *second step* of Woodrow Wilson’s attempt to build a *worldwide* Second Babel through a *Partnership of Democratic Nations*.

The purpose of this Unsealing is to see that the **U.S. Constitution** is associated with each step, when we add the element of “the Woman” to Babel-Babylon as we did in the most recent Unsealings about the 19th Amendment.

Genesis 11:1 (KJV) And THE WHOLE EARTH WAS OF ONE LANGUAGE, and ONE SPEECH [politically, by Making the World Safe for Democracy].

Revelation 17:18 (KJV) And THE WOMAN which thou sawest IS THAT GREAT CITY [Babylon the Great], **which reigneth over the kings of the earth** [by Making the World Safe for Democracy].

Key Understanding: Two steps involving the U.S. Constitution. In the two steps of the attempt to build a worldwide Second Babel of Genesis 11, the U.S. Constitution is involved with each. There is the first step of building a ‘single democratic nation Second Babel’ through the U.S. Constitution of September 17, 1787.

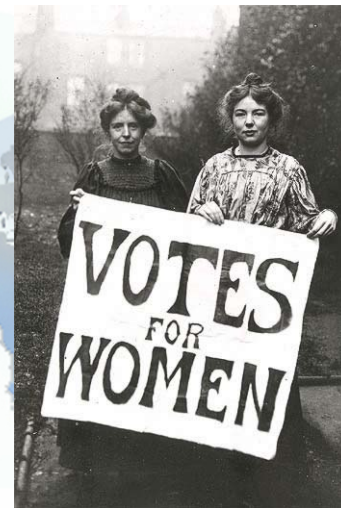
Step 1 – Building a nation as a *second* Babel through the U.S. Constitution



Then, with the added element of women of “the Woman” of Revelation 17:18 helping to Make the World Safe for Democracy, the *second step* of building the *worldwide* Second Babel results in the passage of the 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution on August 26, 1920.

Step 2 – Building the world as a *second* Babel resulted in the 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution
