

#983 The Whore's Latter Rain – In 605 B.C., Nebuchadnezzar's Babylon registered a Pair of Victories over (i) Egypt at the Battle of Carchemish, and (ii) Judah, for the purpose of connecting to the future Revelation 6:05 Black Horse Rider, part 12, The Men o' War Horses in Revelation 9:13-21

We don't see locusts and Men o' War horses together as we do in Revelation 9:1-12, but in Revelation 9:13-21, we see Men o' War horses and horsemen that sure seem similar to the "locusts" of Joel 1-2 and Revelation 9:1-12.

Review (from Unsealing #829): We have referred to this passage of Revelation 9:13-21 before, in Unsealing #829 of the Man o' War series, when we were noting that Armies of Horsemen and Fours (4's) go together. The horse Man o' War prophetically linked (a) Woodrow Wilson and the Body of Americans as an "army of horsemen" with (b) the theme of "four" because Man o' War was born on March 29, 1917, 4 days before Woodrow Wilson's April 2, 1917, war speech. It was noted that the theme of an "army of horsemen" linking exactly with the number "four" happens to be prominent in scripture in the passage of Revelation 9:13-21, with the sounding of the Sixth Trumpet. There is a release of "four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates" who had been prepared for (i) an *hour*, (ii) a *day*, (iii) a *month*, and (iv) a *year*. Note the four (4) items of an *hour*, *day*, *month*, and *year* – all connected with an "army of horsemen" said to number 200,000,000. Clearly, (a) Armies of Horsemen and (b) Four go together.

The Army of the Horsemen and Four

Revelation 9:13-21 (KJV) And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the FOUR angels which are bound in THE GREAT RIVER EUPHRATES.

15 And the FOUR angels were loosed, which were prepared for [i] an hour, and [ii] a day, and [iii] a month, and [iv] a year, for to slay the third part of men.

16 And the number of THE ARMY OF THE HORSEMEN were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.


19 For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.



20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Key Understanding: More horsemen from the pit. Again, in the passage of Revelation 9:13-21 (above), we see an Army of Horsemen, and those horses and horsemen are represented as ascending out of the Bottomless Pit, for “out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.”
