

#1091 The Door of Heaven and the Gate of God – The Two Eliakims: The *second phase* of the curse of the *second* Eliakim (Jehoiakim) and the curse of Elijah (Malachi 4:6), part 3, The *first* Eliakim as a father of the children of Judah, and the Malachi 4:5-6 Elijah turning the heart of the “fathers to the children”

As part of the understanding that the *second phase* of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse of the *second* Eliakim (Jehoiakim) is the fulfillment of the curse of Elijah (Malachi 4:6) . . .

Key Understanding: The “father” theme. There is a “father” theme strongly associated with the *first* Eliakim and a “father” theme strongly associated with the Malachi 4:5-6 Elijah. The *first* Eliakim is as “a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah” (Isaiah 22:21), while Elijah turns “the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers.”

Isaiah 22:20-24 (KJV) And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will call my servant ELIAKIM the son of Hilkiah:

21 And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I WILL COMMIT THY GOVERNMENT INTO HIS HAND: and HE SHALL BE A FATHER TO THE INHABITANTS OF JERUSALEM, AND TO THE HOUSE OF JUDAH.

22 And THE KEY OF THE HOUSE OF DAVID will I lay UPON HIS SHOULDER; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.

23 And I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and HE SHALL BE FOR A GLORIOUS THRONE TO HIS FATHER’S HOUSE. [NAS, . . . And he will become a throne of glory to his father’s house.]

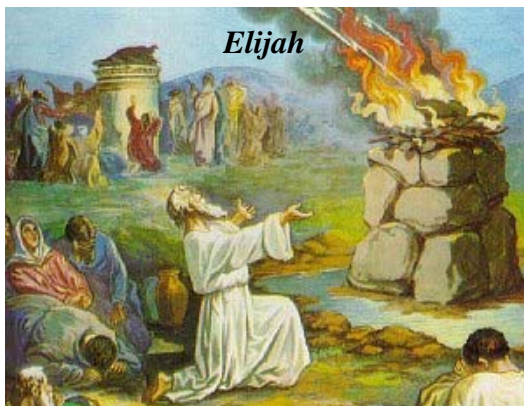
24 And they shall hang upon him all the glory of his father’s house, the offspring and the issue, all vessels of small quantity, from the vessels of cups, even to all the vessels of flagons.

Malachi 4:5-6 (KJV) Behold, I WILL SEND YOU ELIJAH the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

6 And HE SHALL TURN THE HEART OF THE FATHERS TO THE CHILDREN, AND THE HEART OF THE CHILDREN TO THEIR FATHERS, LEST I COME AND SMITE THE EARTH WITH A CURSE.
