



#1119 The Door of Heaven and the Gate of God – The Two Eliakims: The second phase of the curse of the second Eliakim (Jehoiakim) and the curse of Elijah (Malachi 4:6), part 31, Lydia, whose heart the Lord opened

Key Understanding: After the Lord opened the door for Paul to preach the gospel in Europe (Acts 16:9-12), the Lord first reached Lydia of Thyatira, “whose heart the Lord opened.”

This is to be contrasted with those of the U.S. Grant and Woodrow Wilson church of Laodicea, who ultimately have the spirit of Jezebel of Thyatira, and before whom the Lord stands “at the door” of their hearts and knocks. “If any man hear my voice, and open the door [of his heart],” the Lord will help him to overcome and will grant him the right to sit with the Lord on his throne.



Acts 16:14 (KJV) And A CERTAIN WOMAN

NAMED LYDIA, a seller of purple [purple dye for cloth, or purple cloth or fabrics], OF THE CITY OF THYATIRA, which worshipped God [referring to Lydia], heard us:

WHOSE HEART THE LORD OPENED, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

Revelation 3:20-21 (KJV) Behold, I STAND AT THE DOOR, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and OPEN THE DOOR, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

21 To him that overcometh WILL I GRANT to sit with me IN MY THRONE, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my father IN HIS THRONE.
