

#1207 America as Media-Persia – The Daniel 5:26-28 Handwriting on the Wall was fulfilled in 539 B.C.: Media-Persia conquers Babylon

Key Understanding: Media-Persia’s conquest of Babylon is seen at the end of Daniel chapter 5.

We covered Daniel chapter 5 when we addressed the subject matter of the Boston Stump and the Babylon Stump (Unsealings #623–#631). The Boston Stump church in England was instrumental in birthing Babylon the Great as the restoration of the Daniel 5 Belshazzar-Babylon Stump and its roots. Said another way, America as “the Boston Stump,” or “the Boston-Babylon Stump,” represents the restoration of the Daniel 5 Belshazzar-Babylon Stump and its roots.

***Daniel 5:22-31 (KJV) And thou his** [Nebuchadnezzar’s] **son** [descendant, actually grandson], **O Belshazzar, hast not humbled thine heart, though thou knewest all this;**
23 But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou, and thy lords, thy wives, and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, hast thou not glorified:
24 Then was the part of the hand sent from him; and this writing was written.
25 And this is the writing that was written, MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN.
26 This is the interpretation of the thing: MENE; God hath numbered thy kingdom, and finished it.
27 TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.
28 PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.
29 Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and put a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.
30 In that night was Belshazzar the king of the Chaldeans slain.
31 And Darius the Median took the kingdom, being about threescore and two years old.*



11 years and Babel/Babylon. We covered in Unsealings #412–#414 how 11 years is specifically tied to the building of Babel/Babylon because of Genesis 11, discussing the facts that

and explaining why there were 11 years between the births of V. I. Lenin and Alexander Kerensky, and then 11 years between the December 8, 1980, death of John Lennon and the December 8-10, 1991, death of the Marxist-Leninist Soviet Union. Then, in Unsealing #949, we discussed that the Lord again used 11 years historically/prophetically in connection with the building of a *second* Genesis 11 Babel. There were 11 years between the April 9, 1906, birth of the Latter Rain Pentecostal movement and the April 6 [= 9], 1917, U.S. entry into World War I, representing the U.S. attempting to build a *worldwide* Second Babel through a Partnership of Democratic Nations, to Make the World Safe for Democracy.

Key Understanding: *The Daniel 5:26-28 handwriting on the wall was fulfilled in 539 B.C.* The “handwriting on the wall” for the *first* Babylon, meaning the conquering of the *first* Babylon by Media-Persia, is seen in scripture in Daniel 5:28, actually occurring in history in 539 B.C.

528 + 11 = 539, or, 539 B.C. + 11 years = 528 B.C.

The point is that $528 + 11 = 539$, or, $539 \text{ B.C.} + 11 \text{ years} = 528 \text{ B.C.}$, which is the number of the verse (Daniel 5:28) about the defeat of the Babylonians by the Medes and the Persians. Thus, the Lord once again tied the number 11 to Babel/Babylon. The *conquering* of the *first* Babylon in 539 B.C. was tied to the theme of 11 years (because 539 B.C. was 11 years before 528 B.C., which is equivalent to the verse number of 5:28), while the *building* of America as a *second* Babylon surrounded 11 years, as is shown in the paragraph *above*.

Daniel 5:28 (KJV) PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.
