

#1292 The Mark of the Beast – The Feast of Unleavened Bread represents deliverance out of bondage in the Old Testament, which is why leaven represents sin in the New Testament

Exodus 12:15 (KJV) Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; EVEN THE FIRST DAY YE SHALL PUT AWAY LEAVEN OUT OF YOUR HOUSES: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

Key Understanding: *In the New Testament, leaven = sin. The Feast of Unleavened Bread represents deliverance out of bondage, which is why in the New Testament leaven represents sin. The eating of unleavened bread in the act of the Passover, or the Lord's Supper, or Communion, or the Eucharist, is a reminder that a Christian is to become spiritually unleavened by removing sin from his or her life.*

Galatians 5:7-9 (KJV) Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth? {hinder you: or, drive you back} 8 This persuasion cometh not of him that calleth you.


9 A LITTLE LEAVEN LEAVENETH THE WHOLE LUMP.

1 Corinthians 5:4-8 (KJV) In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, 5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

6 Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that A LITTLE LEAVEN LEAVENETH THE WHOLE LUMP?

7 PURGE OUT THEREFORE THE OLD LEAVEN, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even CHRIST OUR PASSOVER is sacrificed for us: [NIV . . . Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast — as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.]

8 Therefore let us keep the feast, NOT WITH OLD LEAVEN, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; BUT WITH THE UNLEAVENED BREAD OF SINCERITY AND TRUTH. {the feast: or, holyday}
