

#1351 America as Media-Persia, II – The Silver Kingdom, part 5, The Aspen Connections, (ii), Margaret Thatcher’s Memoirs about August 2, 1990, and the “Events at Aspen”

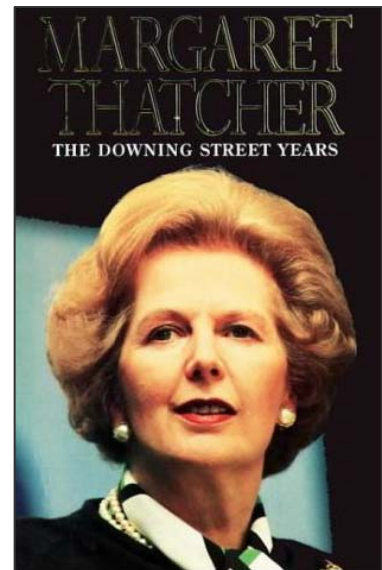
August 2, 1990, Aspen, Colorado. On August 2, 1990, the same day that Saddam Hussein-led Iraq invaded Kuwait, U.S. President George H. W. Bush, the 41st, was flying into Aspen, Colorado, to speak at the Aspen Institute. It was there that major decisions were made concerning the response by Britain and the U.S. to the invasion. Memoirs of Margaret Thatcher detail the “Events at Aspen” and are in #1351–Doc 1, *below*.

Key Understanding: August 2, 1990, at Aspen, Colorado, the Silver City.
