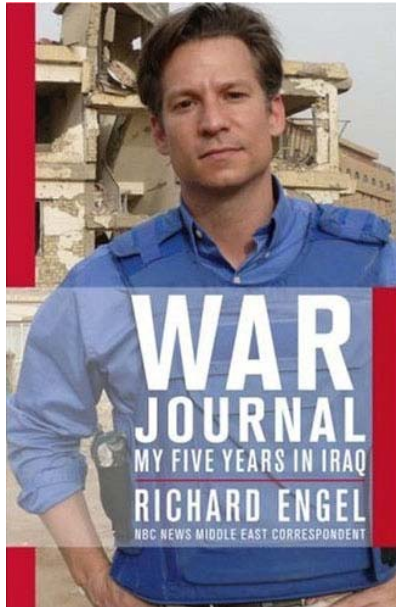


#1360 America as Media-Persia, II – The Media was “embedded” with the (Media-Persian) United States troops and British troops at the beginning of the 2003 Iraq War and during the defeat of Saddam Hussein

Daniel 2:31-32 (KJV) Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible.

*32 This image’s **HEAD WAS OF FINE GOLD** [Babylon], **HIS BREAST AND HIS ARMS OF SILVER** [Media-Persia], **HIS BELLY AND HIS THIGHS OF BRASS** [Alexander the Great’s Greece],*



For the sake of continuing on with the subject matter of the media being prophetically associated with America as Media-Persia, we are jumping from the 1991 Gulf War, which was an *incomplete* defeat of the Saddam Hussein regime as *pretender* Babylon by George H. W. Bush, to the 2003 Iraq War, which represented the *complete* defeat of the Saddam Hussein regime by George W. Bush.

The “embedded” reporters during the 2003 Iraq War. Around 600 reporters/journalists were “embedded” with military units, mostly British and American, during the beginning days and weeks of the Iraq War. The Pentagon established the policy of “embedding” reporters with military units. It seemed to be a wise tactic on the part of the Pentagon, perhaps producing reports that were more favorable if they were from journalists embedded with the troops rather than the same journalists working from their desks elsewhere.

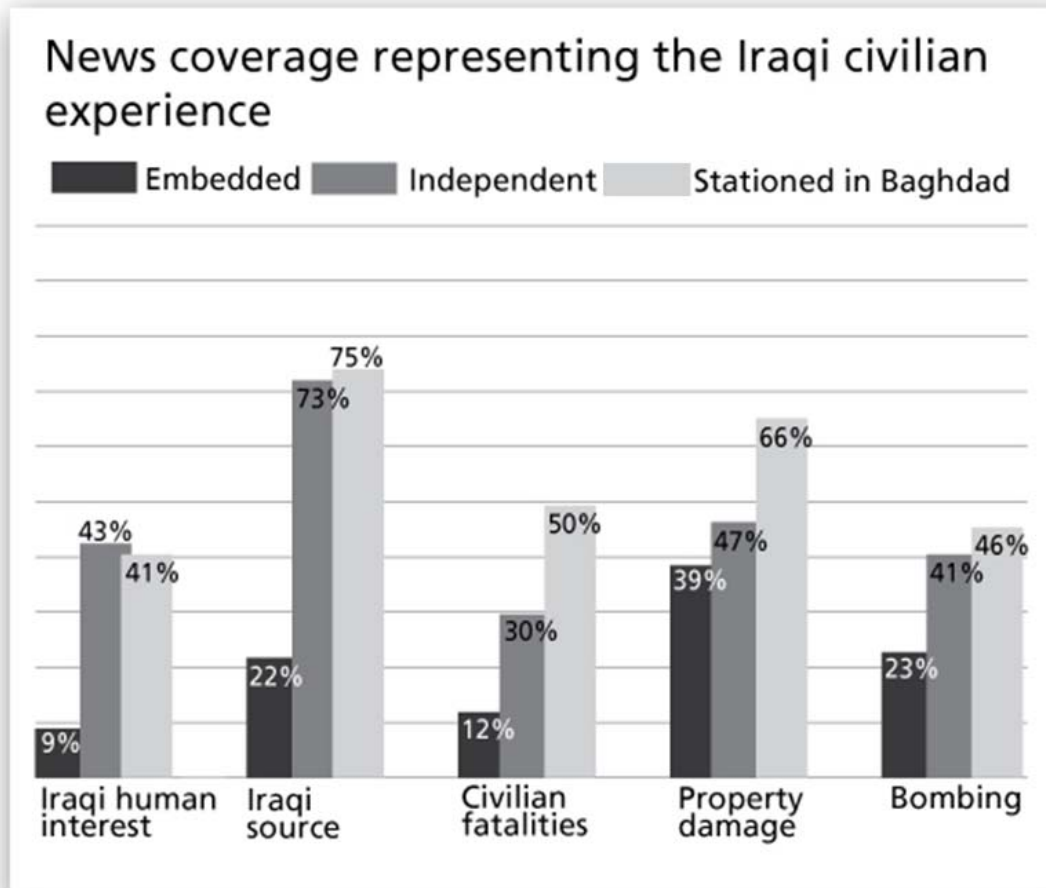
Key Understanding: The media embedded with Media-Persia. In the war to finish off Saddam Hussein, in the course of America filling out its role as the *second* (but *counterfeit*) ‘Cyrus the Great’ Media-Persia, the Lord ordained that a key component of the media’s coverage of the war was that it was *embedded* with U.S. and British troops. The Lord ordained that the media be *embedded* with the American troops in the Iraq War to reveal and emphasize America’s role as the *second* (but *counterfeit*) Media-Persia in its defeat of Saddam Hussein-led Iraq, which was in the role of *pretender* Babylon.
