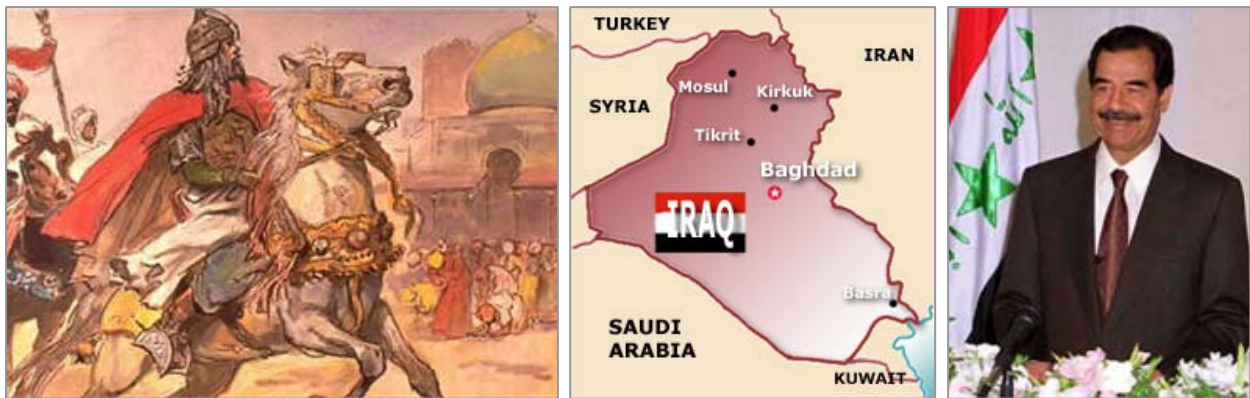


#1389 America as Media-Persia and the Building of Israel – Defeating Saddam Hussein, who wanted the role of Saladin, part 1, The modern day significance of Saladin in the Arab world

***Saladin* was the greatest Muslim warrior of the 1100's. He precipitated the Third Crusade by defeating (Crusader) Christians at the Battle of the Horns of Hattin in 1187, triumphantly entering Jerusalem.**

Saladin the hero. Because Saladin liberated Palestine (in the eyes of the Muslims) from the European Crusaders, he is an inspiration to many Arabs and Muslims in the modern day Arab struggle against the Jews having a homeland in Palestine. Furthermore, the glory and comparative unity of the Arab world under Saladin was seen as the perfect symbol and model for the new unity that was sought by Arab nationalists such as Gamal Abdel Nasser of Egypt. It was for this reason that the *Eagle of Saladin* became the symbol of revolutionary Egypt under Nasser. Later, one of the brigades of the PLO (Palestine Liberation Organization) would be called *Hattin*.

Key Understanding: *Saladin and Saddam Hussein were each born in Tikrit.* Remarkably, Saladin was born (c. 1138) in Tikrit, a small town located in the modern nation of Iraq, just as Saddam Hussein would be birthed (April 28, 1937) in Tikrit. Therefore, it was easy for Saddam Hussein to view himself as a *second* Saladin (who conquered Jerusalem in 1187 A.D.), just as he viewed himself as a *second* Nebuchadnezzar (who conquered Jerusalem in 587 B.C.). Clearly, the most famous common denominator of Nebuchadnezzar and Saladin was their conquering of Jerusalem.

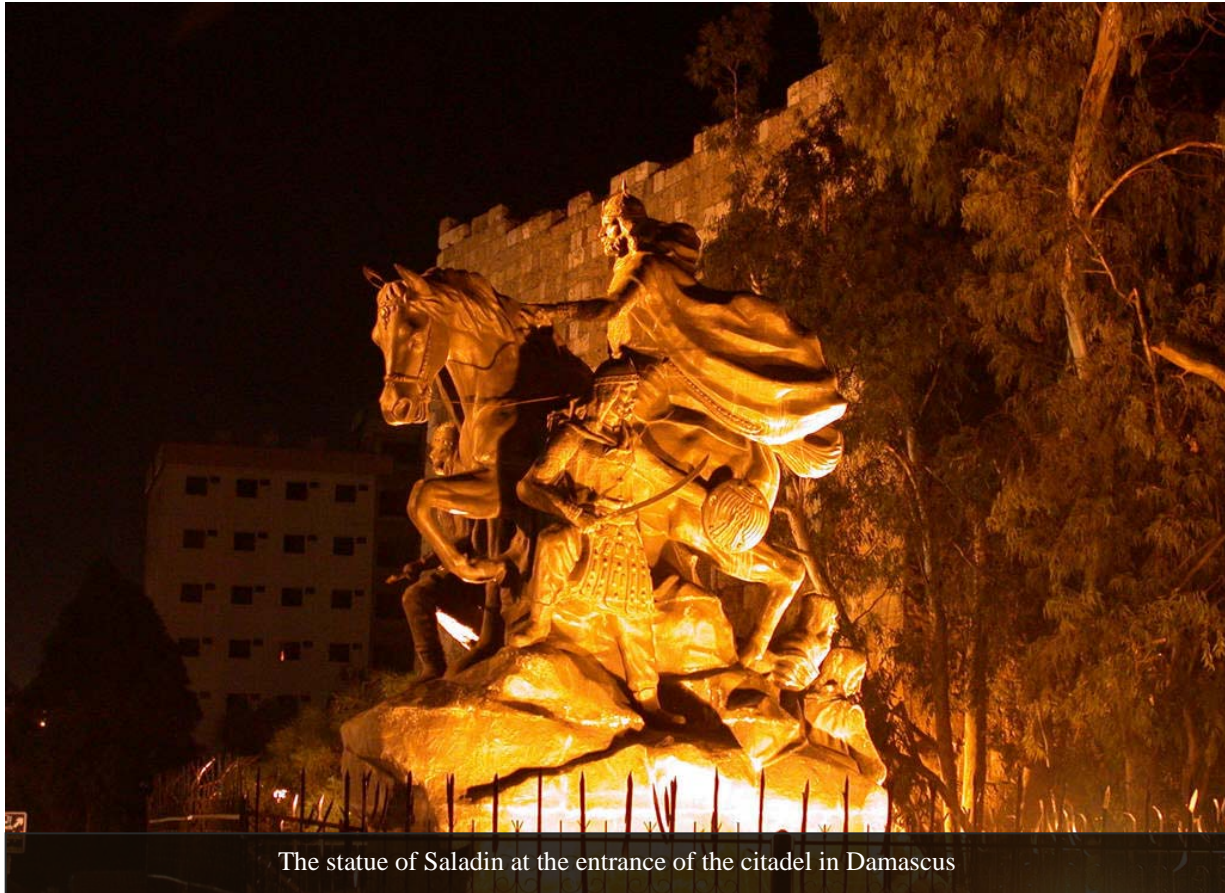
