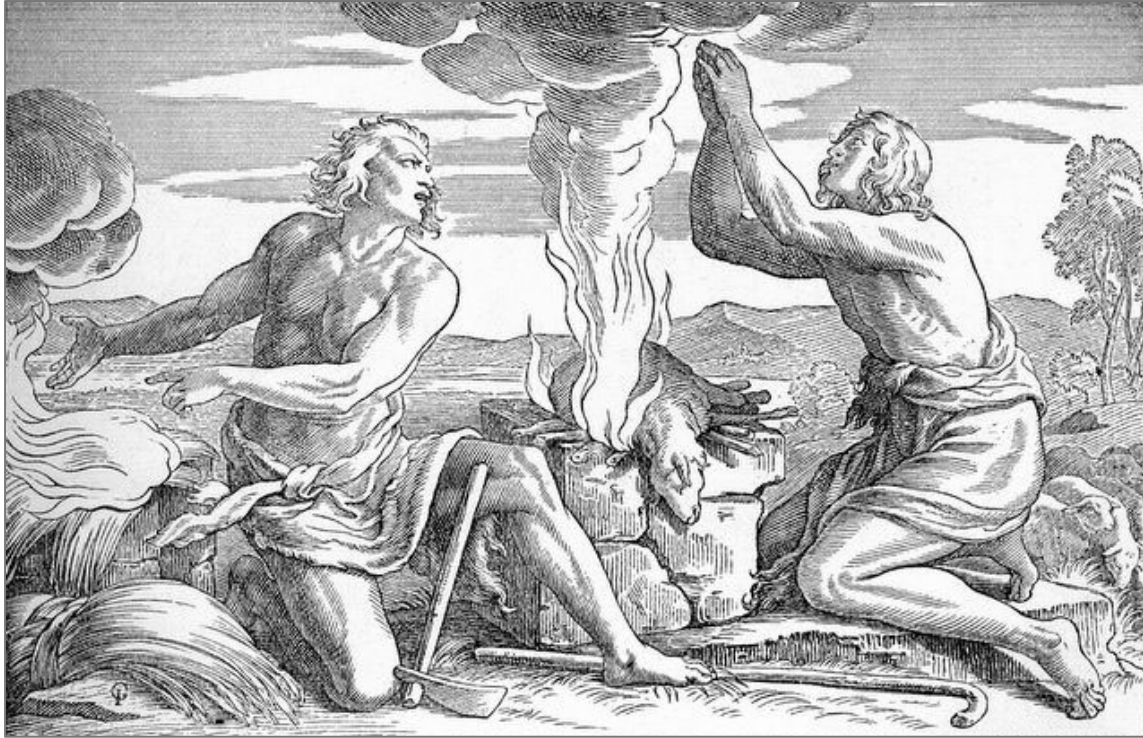
5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

Key Understanding: Below is a list of the series of 4’s (fours) leading up to and surrounding the latter day(s) fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 through Harry Truman and the atomic bomb.



- 1. The Four Freedoms (on Epiphany, 1941)** – President Franklin D. Roosevelt, in a message to Congress on Epiphany, January 6, 1941, said that any settlements made after World War II should be based on “four freedoms” that everyone in the world ought to enjoy. He defined the “four freedoms” as freedom of speech, freedom of religion, freedom from want, and freedom from fear.
- 2. Mount Rushmore with its Four Presidents** – Mount Rushmore, a monumental granite sculpture, is a memorial to four U.S. Presidents, George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln. The sculptor, Gutzon Borglum, died on March 6, 1941, before the carving was completed.
- 3. The Four Terms of Franklin D. Roosevelt** – President Franklin D. Roosevelt served as President of the U.S. for more than 12 years, longer than any other person, and was the only President elected to the office four times.
- 4. The Four Years from the August 9, 1941, first day of the Atlantic Charter conference of Roosevelt and Churchill to the August 9, 1945, Atomic Bomb** – The Four Freedoms of January 6, 1941, were incorporated into the Atlantic Charter, which expressed the post-World War II aims of the United States and Great Britain, though the United States would not enter the war for another four months.
- 5. The Four-Power Rule over Germany** – The four Allied powers of the United States, Britain, France, and the Soviet Union divided and governed Germany at the end of World War II.

Each of the five listed *above* will be discussed in upcoming Unsealings. The reason why each of the five occurred as they did – associated with the number 4 (four) – is because each was a part of the overall picture of the prophetic story of the Abomination of Desolation, which has its roots in the *proper* sacrifices of Abel seen in Genesis 4:4.
