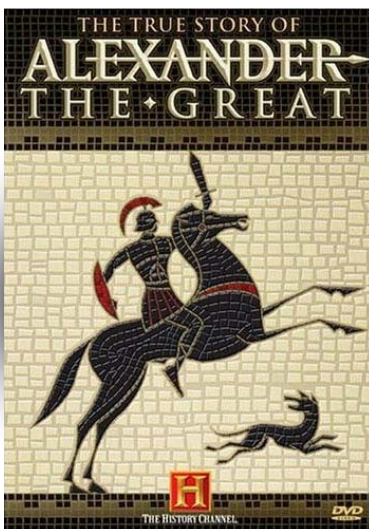


#1675 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4’s (fours) leading up to and surrounding the latter day(s) fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 through Harry Truman and the Atomic Bomb, part 5c, The Four-Power Rule over Germany: Adolf Hitler as a second Alexander the Great, (i)

*Daniel 8:8 (KJV) Therefore **THE HE GOAT** [Alexander the Great’s Grecian Empire] **WAXED VERY GREAT** [which is why the Lord ordained Alexander to be known to history as ‘the Great’]: and when he was strong, **THE GREAT HORN WAS BROKEN** [Alexander the Great’s premature death in 323 B.C.]; and for it [from it] came up **FOUR NOTABLE ONES** [the 4 (four) kingdoms of Ptolemy, Seleucus, Cassander, and Lysimachus] **TOWARD THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN.***

Key Understanding: Hitler as a second Alexander the Great. Adolf Hitler has often been compared to Alexander the Great because (a) of the belief that both were bent on world conquest, and because (b) the empire of each lasted but for a short space of time. (Alexander the Great reigned for 12-13 years, dying on June 10, 323 B.C.; Adolf Hitler led Germany for 12 years and 3 months, from January 30, 1933, to his death on April 30, 1945.)

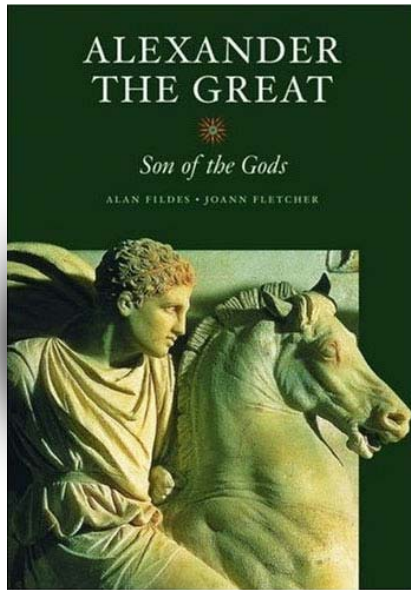


Here is what one source says:

Modern history also records some leaders who aspired for the same glory enjoyed by the ancient warrior-leaders. Some accounts claim that Adolf Hitler often dreamt of leading Nazi Germany to conquer the world, much like Alexander led the Macedonians. By this time, one of the prevalent myths about Alexander was that he was intent on conquering the world, purifying it by the sword. In some ways, Hitler saw [in this] a reflection of his own mission of reclaiming Aryan supremacy. By patterning himself after history’s greatest general, he was of course exercising nothing more than self-aggrandizement because Hitler can hardly be considered a military man.

Here is the shadow fulfillment of Daniel 8:8, with Adolf Hitler as a *second* Alexander the Great:

Daniel 8:8 (KJV) Therefore THE HE GOAT [Germany] WAXED VERY GREAT: and when he was strong, THE GREAT HORN WAS BROKEN [Adolf Hitler's suicide on April 30, 1945, and Nazi Germany's surrender on May 7, 1945, ending 12 years of rule]; and for it [from it] came up FOUR NOTABLE ONES [represented by the Four-Power Rule over post-World War II Germany by the United States, Great Britain, France, and the USSR] TOWARD THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN.
