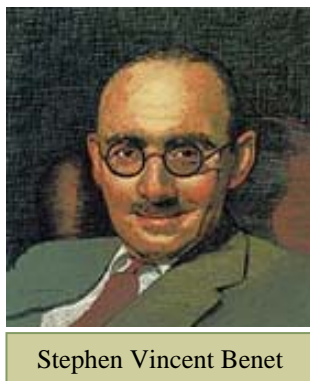
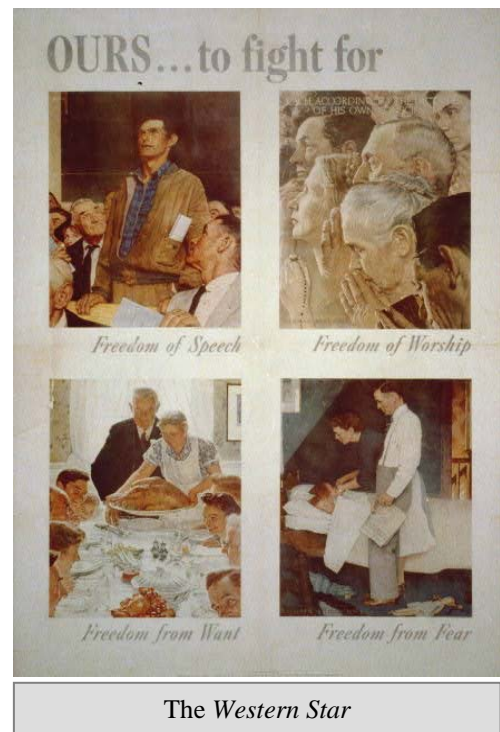


#1688 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – Hitler (vs. the U.S.) waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 6, The March 13, 1943, ‘Freedom from Fear’ death of Stephen Vincent Benet: The Epiphany Western Star (and a Bethlehem birth) vs. the Epiphany Star in the East (and the Bethlehem birth)

Review (from the previous Unsealing): *Western Star and Epiphany, January 6, 1941*. Stephen Vincent Benet’s description of the United States of America as the *Western Star* is both patriotically and prophetically attached to the Four Freedoms of Epiphany, January 6, 1941, through Benet’s essay on Freedom from Fear in the March 13, 1943, edition of the *Saturday Evening Post*, the date of his death.

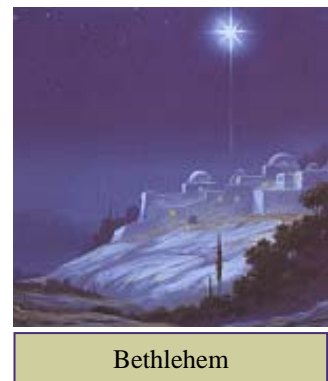
Key Understanding #1: *Western Star and Epiphany, of January 6, 1941, vs. the Epiphany ‘Star in the East’ birth of Jesus Christ*. The Lord ordained Stephen Vincent Benet’s *Western Star* to be attached to the January 6, 1941, Four Freedoms for the purpose of vividly revealing that the birth of the Four Freedoms on Epiphany, January 6, 1941, was representing the (birth and destiny of the) United States as a whole as the Antichrist *Western Star* in contrast and in opposition to the Epiphany *Star in the East*, representing the revealing of and the birth of the true Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Matthew 2:1-2 (KJV) Now when JESUS WAS BORN IN BETHLEHEM of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men [Magi] from the east to Jerusalem, 2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his STAR IN THE EAST, and are come to worship him.

Key Understanding #2: *The Western Star from Bethlehem*. Furthermore, the Lord ordained Stephen Vincent Benet to be born (July 22, 1898) in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, to reveal his role as a ‘spirit of Antichrist’ child of the *Western Star* in contrast to the Bethlehem birth of the true Christ child, Jesus Christ – with its attachment to the *Star in the East*.

Key Understanding #3: Thus, both (a) the July 22, 1898, birth of Stephen Vincent Benet (because it was in *Bethlehem*) and (b) the March 13, 1943, death of Stephen Vincent Benet (because it was linked to the *Four Freedoms*) were connected to Epiphany.
