



#1765 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 24, Irving Berlin: World War I (and Irving Berlin), World War II (and Irving Berlin), and the Cold War (and Irving Berlin)


Key Understanding #1: The Lord ordained the life of Irving Berlin to *literally* impact World War I and World War II, and the life and/or death of Irving Berlin to *prophetically* encompass World War I, World War II, and the Cold War.

World War I and Irving Berlin: *Yip Yip Yaphank* – In 1917, during World War I, Irving Berlin entered the U.S. Army and staged a musical revue, *Yip Yip Yaphank*, while at Camp Upton in Yaphank, New York. The show’s cast consisted of 350 members of the armed forces. The revue was a patriotic tribute to the U.S. Army. Berlin composed a song entitled “God Bless America” for the show, but decided against using it. The song was released over two decades later, in 1938.




World War II and Irving Berlin: *This is the Army* – The success of *Yip Yip Yaphank* during World War I inspired Irving Berlin to volunteer to do a similar revue, *This is the Army*, during World War II. After receiving permission from General George Marshall, it was staged on Broadway, opening on July 4, 1942, with a cast of over 300 servicemen. A smash hit, it ran for three years, with the military taking it to London and Europe, and to the men fighting in the Pacific theatre. The show, as well as the fictionalized story of its production, was also turned into the 1943 motion picture, *This is the Army*.

The Cold War and Irving Berlin: *The death of Irving Berlin* – The September 22, 1989, death of Irving Berlin is prophetically connected to the November 9-11, 1989, fall of the Berlin Wall, which was tied to the fall of East Germany, the dismantling of the Warsaw Pact, and the eventual 1991 demise of the Soviet Union.



Key Understanding #2: *Irving Berlin and World War I, World War II, and the Cold War.* The fact that Irving Berlin is a major prophetic face of the United States in the fulfillment of its role as the *stern-faced king* in Daniel 8:23, and the fact that Irving Berlin is so closely tied to World War I, World War II, and the Cold War, point to the fact that the *stern-faced king* of Daniel 8:23 encompasses the entire span of time and events that include World War I, World War II, and the Cold War. In other words, Irving Berlin represented the United States as the Daniel 8:23 *stern-faced king* in World War I, in World War II, and in the Cold War. Furthermore . . .



Key Understanding #3: *Irving Berlin and Woodrow Wilson, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Ronald Reagan.* It is more comprehensive to add the respective Presidents of the United States to those events and time periods. It can be said that Irving Berlin and Woodrow Wilson represented the United States as the Daniel 8:23 *stern-faced king* in World War I; Irving Berlin and Franklin D. Roosevelt/Harry Truman represented the United States as the Daniel 8:23 *stern-faced king* in World War II; Irving Berlin and Ronald Reagan represented the United States as the Daniel 8:23 *stern-faced king* in the Cold War.

A MASTER OF INTRIGUE], SHALL ARISE [NIV . . . WILL ARISE].
