

#1795 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 54, *Irving Berlin and God Bless America: Sudden Sea: The Hurricane of 1938 and the Ocean White with Foam*

While the storm clouds gather far across the sea,
Let us swear allegiance to a land that's free,
Let us all be grateful for a land so fair,
As we raise our voices in a solemn prayer.

God bless America, land that I love
Stand beside her and guide her
Through the night with the light from above
From the mountains To the prairies,
To the ocean white with foam
God bless America, My home sweet home.

The words *above* are from the November 10, 1938, debut of "God Bless America." On the *right* is a picture of an ocean white with foam, produced by the Great New England Hurricane of September 21, 1938.



Key Understanding: *The ocean white with foam.* The theme of the sea/ocean was prevalent in "God Bless America" as it was introduced to the nation on November 10, 1938. Irving Berlin's introduction to the song began "While the storm clouds gather far across the sea," while the lyrics included "To the ocean white with foam." The Lord ordained the September 21, 1938, Great New England Hurricane – which is a large part of the prophetic story surrounding the introduction of "God Bless America" to the nation on November 10, 1938 – to be all about *storm clouds gathered at sea and the ocean white with foam.* The storm clouds were literally gathered and the ocean was literally white with foam on September 21, 1938.

Here is #1795–Doc 1, about *Sudden Sea*, a book written about the 1938 Great New England Hurricane. The title underscores the significance of the *sea/ocean* in association with the hurricane.

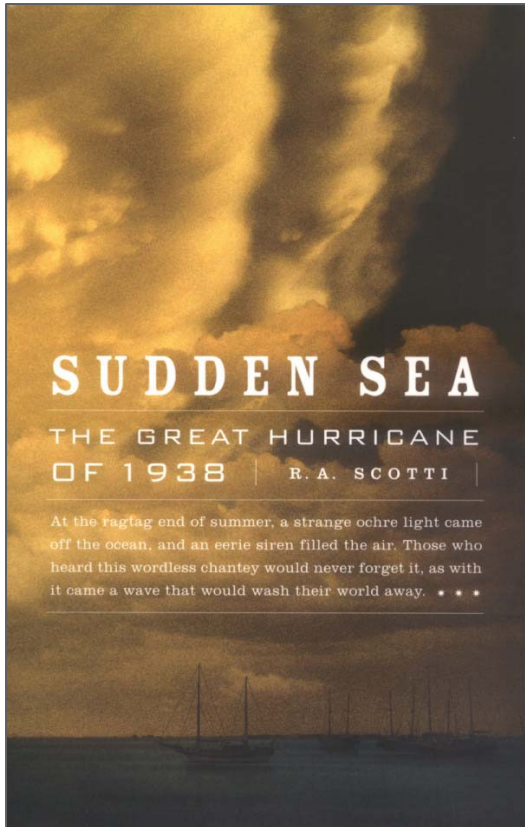
