

#1798 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 57, *Irving Berlin and God Bless America: The Great Nazi Germany Wind of September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, blew against Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America* (continued)

Key Understanding (which is the same as is in the previous Unsealing): *The great Nazi Germany wind of September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, blew against the earthly nations of Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America. Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America stood firm against the Nazi German wind as if they were founded upon a rock. But in reality, though Britain and America did not fall in the natural, the Church (Church-ill) itself – that is, those who are supposed to be the mighty men and the holy people of God – fell spiritually (or more correctly, added to and illustrated its already state of fallenness) when the Hitler wind blew, because the Church-ill house was built upon the sand (of Britain and America).*



The prophetic understanding of the “miracle of Dunkirk” – seen in the repeat of Unsealing [#673](#) below – helps to clarify this understanding, for the same Nazi wind that blew on September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, was blowing at Dunkirk on May 26, 1940.

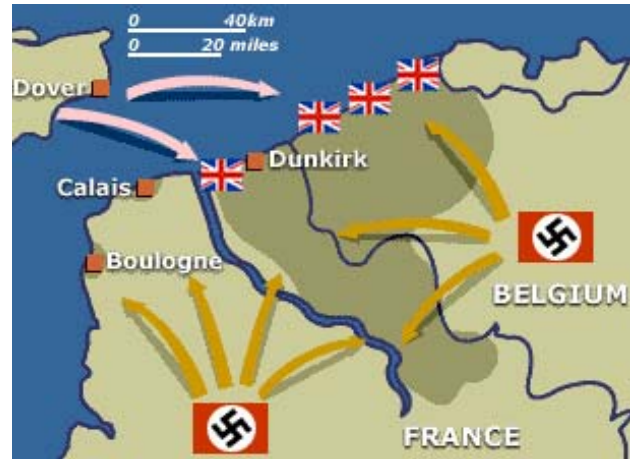
#673 Dunkirk – Winston Churchill and Dunkirk

Toward Dunkirk in World War II. Two events occurred on May 10, 1940. On that date, Winston Churchill became the Prime Minister of Great Britain. Also on that date, Adolf Hitler began his invasion of Western Europe. Tens of thousands of British and French soldiers who had rushed to help Belgium became surrounded and trapped by the Germans on the beaches at Dunkirk, France.



Known as the Miracle of Dunkirk, the nine days of Dunkirk stopped what was already a disastrous campaign from becoming a tragedy of epic proportions. *Above right* is a picture of British troops awaiting evacuation off of Dunkirk’s beaches.

On May 26, 1940, the dramatics of the gigantic rescue evacuation(s) at Dunkirk would begin to unfold. Churchill, prophetically representing an ‘ill Church,’ famously called it the “miracle of Dunkirk.” [More specifics of the story will be discussed in the next Unsealing.]



Key Understanding: May 26, 1940, and Matthew 7:26. Prophetically, the “miracle of Dunkirk” will be seen to represent exactly what the literal name of Dunkirk means – church on the dunes, or, quite specifically, church on the sand. The “miracle of Dunkirk” began to unfold on May 26, 1940, in fulfillment of Matthew 7:26. [May 26 + the 2-month date change = July 26 = 7:26 = Matthew 7:26. Remember, the 5th month of the old Julian calendar was July.]

Matthew 7:26 – Church on the Sand

Matthew 7:21-29 (KJV) Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

*26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto **A FOOLISH MAN, WHICH BUILT HIS HOUSE UPON THE SAND:***

27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

29 For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
