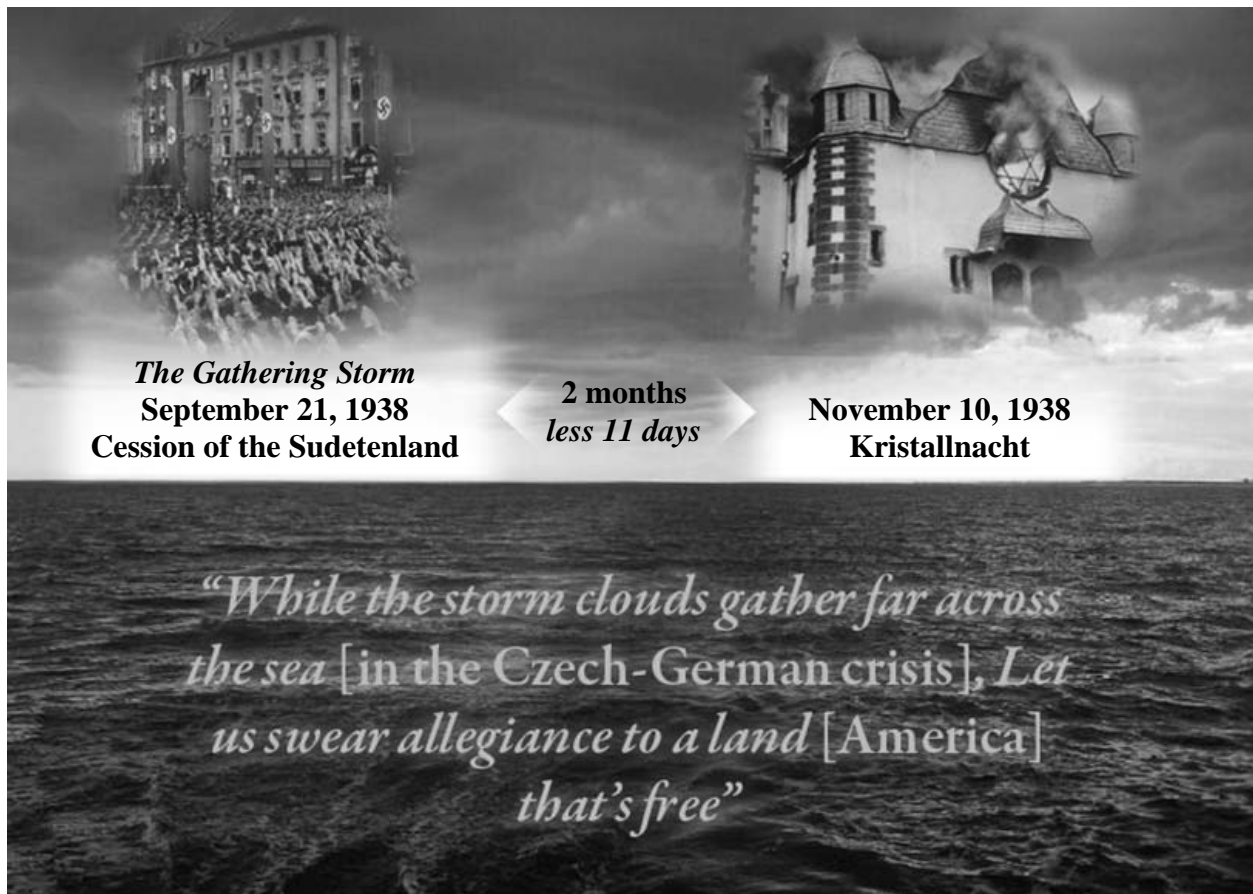


#1800 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 59, *Irving Berlin and God Bless America: The Great Nazi Germany Wind of September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, blew against Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America* (continued)

Review (from the previous three Unsealings): *The great Nazi Germany wind of September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, blew against the earthly nations of Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America.* Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America stood firm against the Nazi German wind *as if* they were founded upon a rock. But in reality, though Britain and America did not fall in the *natural*, the Church (Church-ill) itself – that is, those who are supposed to be *the mighty men and the holy people of God* – fell *spiritually* (or more correctly, added to and illustrated its already state of fallenness) when the Hitler wind blew, because the Church-ill house was built upon the sand (of Britain and America).

Key Understanding: In fact, the spoken introduction to “God Bless America” illustrates that the Church-ill, fully represented by “God” in “God Bless America,” is built upon (the sand of) America, for the encouraged response to the storm clouds gathering across the sea is to “swear allegiance to a land that’s free.”
