


#1802 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 61, **Irving Berlin and God Bless America: Great was the Fall of it, or, Why the Great Hurricane of 1938 and the Great Nazi Germany Wind occurred at the approach of the autumnal equinox (the first day of Fall)**

The Fall Hurricane. A major part of the story of the September 21, 1938, Great New England Hurricane was/is that the great flooding it caused occurred because the timing of the landfall of the hurricane was approaching the autumnal (fall) equinox and was at the time of a new moon, conditions which create the highest tides.



Wind gusts of well over 120 mph brought down the steeple of the oldest church (*pictured left*) in Danielson, Connecticut, during the 1938 hurricane. Thousands of churches were severely damaged in the autumnal equinox hurricane, illustrating the “fall” of the Church-ill that was/is prophetically associated with the event.

**Matthew 7:26-27 (KJV) And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, WHICH BUILT HIS HOUSE UPON THE [Dunkirk, or Church on the Sand] SAND:
27 AND THE RAIN DESCENDED, AND THE FLOODS CAME, AND THE WINDS BLEW, AND BEAT UPON THAT HOUSE; AND IT FELL: and GREAT WAS THE FALL OF IT.**

Key Understanding: Great was the fall of it. The Lord ordained the Great New England Hurricane to occur on September 21, near the autumnal (fall) equinox, primarily to point to the hurricane’s role in a modern day fulfillment of Matthew 7:27. The hurricane was pointing to and representing the great Nazi Germany wind of September 21, 1938, and November 10, 1938, which blew against the nations of Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America. Church-ill Britain and Church-ill America stood firm against the Nazi German

wind *as if* they were founded upon a rock. But in reality, though Britain and America did not fall in the *natural*, the Church (Church-ill) itself – that is, those who are supposed to be *the mighty men and the holy people of God* – fell *spiritually* (or more correctly, added to and illustrated its already state of fallenness) when the Hitler wind blew, because the Church-ill house was built upon the sand (of Britain and America). And great was the *Fall of it*.
