

**#1809** The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 68, *Irving Berlin and God Bless America: The Lord ordained that it would be a man named Churchill who opposed Hitler*

**Key Understanding: Churchill.** Winston Churchill was known and is remembered as the man who led his nation to stand alone against Adolf Hitler and Nazi Germany. Churchill's opposition to Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain's policy of appeasement toward Hitler regarding the Czech-German crisis of September 1938 made him the natural replacement for Chamberlain as Prime Minister of Great Britain, a position he stepped into on May 10, 1940. Churchill's stand against Hitler during and after Germany's invasion of Western Europe reaped him the admiration of the Free World and *Time* magazine's award for the 1940 Man of the Year.



*Below* is a repeat of Unsealing [#1696](#), for the purpose of better understanding why the Lord would choose a man named *Churchill* to lead Britain to stand alone against Adolf Hitler, which will be further addressed in the next Unsealing. *For his stand against Hitler and Nazi Germany, Winston Churchill received Time magazine's award for Man of the Year in 1940. The issue date was Epiphany, January 6, 1941, the date of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's Four Freedoms speech.*

**Key Understanding:** *The two competing realms of a second Antiochus IV Epiphanes are seen in Time magazine's Man of the Year issue of January 6, 1941. The prophetic theme of the spirit of two competing second Syrias during World War II, each with its second Antiochus IV Epiphanes, (i) Nazi Germany with Adolf Hitler, and (ii) the United States of America with its presidents, particularly Roosevelt and Truman, is further intricately woven together by the fact that Winston Churchill – because of his leadership of Great Britain in the stand against Hitler and Nazi Germany – received Time's 1940 Man of the Year award, in the Time magazine issue dated January 6, 1941. Roosevelt's Four Freedoms speech was given on the same day, essentially in opposition to the actions of Hitler and Nazi Germany.*



In summary, the *Time* magazine Man of the Year issue of January 6, 1941, was a part of the intricate weaving together by the Lord of the history of the two competing *second* Antiochus IVs Epiphanes.

*Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the competing *second* Syria, Germany] CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN [Nazi Germany's Adolf Hitler], which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND.*
