

#1861 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 120, *An Angel riding in the Whirlwind and directing the Storm: 9-11* occurred when it did – on September 11, 2001 – in fulfillment of George W. Bush’s quoting of Ecclesiastes 9:11 in his inaugural speech

Review (from the previous Unsealing): *The angel Gabriel riding in the whirlwinds and directing the storms of the Revolutionary War and the Iraq War.* If it was the angel Gabriel who was prophetically designed by the Lord to be the angel who rode in the whirlwind and directed the storm of the ‘John Page/Thomas Jefferson’ Revolutionary War, then the Lord meant for it to be the angel Gabriel who rode in the whirlwind and directed the storm of the ‘George W. Ecclesiastes 9:11 is clearly seen in George W. Bush’s quote of John Page.

Ecclesiastes 9:11 (KJV) I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all.

Nahum 1:3 – which is in the midst of a passage that warns of the Lord’s anger against Nineveh (representing the Assyrian Empire) – is also clearly seen in George W. Bush’s quote of John Page.

Nahum 1:3 (KJV) The LORD is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked: the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds are the dust of his feet.



Key Understanding: What is known as ‘9-11’ – the terrorist attack on New York City on September 11, 2001 – occurred on 9/11 because the event marked the beginning of the fulfillment of President George W. Bush’s words in his January 20, 2001, inaugural address, in which he quoted John Page, who in turn had drawn from Ecclesiastes 9:11 in his letter to Thomas Jefferson. *The race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong of Ecclesiastes 9:11 was combined with the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm of Nahum 1:3.* The whirlwind and the storm of the war on terrorism and the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq came as a result of 9-11. The purpose of the wars from America’s perspective was/is to bring to the world the democracy that began with Thomas Jefferson’s Declaration of Independence.
