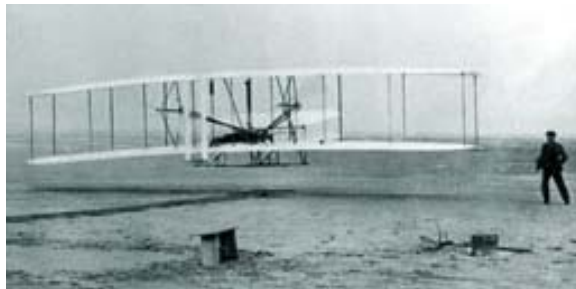

Keith Glennan, announced that the first man-in-space program for the United States would be called Project Mercury.



This announcement occurred on the 55th anniversary of the Wright Brothers’ first flight because it marked the beginning of the *counterfeit* fulfillment of Micah 5:5 by Project Mercury and its Seven Shepherds.
