

#1879 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 138, *An Angel riding in the Whirlwind and directing the Storm: The Micah 5:5 Assyrian vs. the Micah 5:5 Seven Shepherds, (xii), The sixth and final flight of the Mercury Seven ended on May 16, 1963*

Gordon Cooper and Faith 7. The sixth (6th) and last Mercury 7 mission was Faith 7 with Gordon Cooper (*right*) aboard. The mission lasted 34 hours over the course of two days, May 15-16, 1963. Alan Shepard was the back-up astronaut for Gordon Cooper on Faith 7. (Faith 7 is pictured on the launch pad on the *far right*.)



Key Understanding: The final Mercury 7 mission ended on May 16, 1963, finalizing the first phase of America’s space program in preparation for its second phase, Gemini. With the 11-day date change, May 16 = May 5. Thus, both the *beginning* of the Mercury 7 program and the *ending* of the Mercury 7 program were attached to (i) Alan Shepard (because Shepard was the back-up astronaut for the final mission) and (ii) May 5 (because May 16 = May 5), all linked together in a massive *counterfeit* fulfillment of the Micah 5:5 *seven shepherds*.

Micah 5:5-6 (KJV) And this man shall be the peace, WHEN THE ASSYRIAN SHALL COME INTO OUR LAND: and when he shall tread in our palaces, THEN WE SHALL RAISE AGAINST HIM SEVEN SHEPHERDS, and eight principal men.

6 And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: **THUS SHALL HE DELIVER US FROM THE ASSYRIAN**, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.
