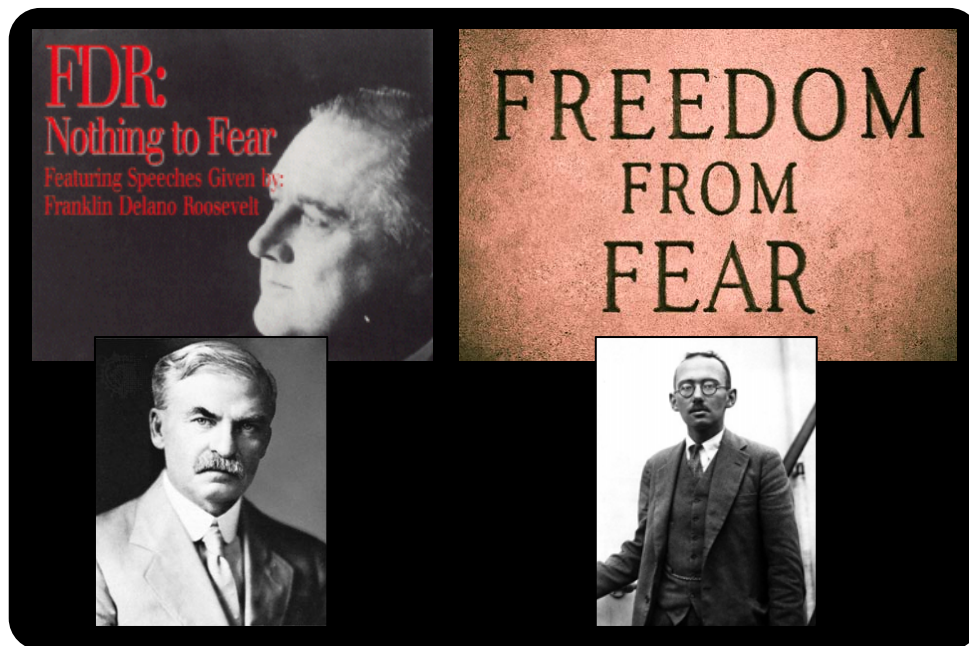


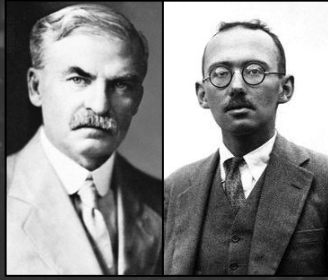
#1915 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 174, *The Teapot Dome Scandal and the fall of Albert Fall: The ‘nothing to fear’ death of Thomas Walsh and the ‘freedom from fear’ death of Stephen Vincent Benet represented the same warning from the Lord*

Review (from Unsealing [#1907](#)): The remarkable ‘Freedom from Fear’ death of Stephen Vincent Benet on March 13, 1943 – the exact day/date of the edition of the *Saturday Evening Post* that carried his essay on Freedom from Fear – was constructed by the Lord as a warning that the fearless Christian Gentiles were being “cut off” through the *Christian Holocaust* in simultaneity with the Jews being judged through the *Jewish Holocaust*. The Lord cutting off Stephen Vincent Benet through a *physical* death was symbolic of the Lord cutting off ‘freedom from fear of the Lord’ Christian Gentiles with eternal *spiritual* death.

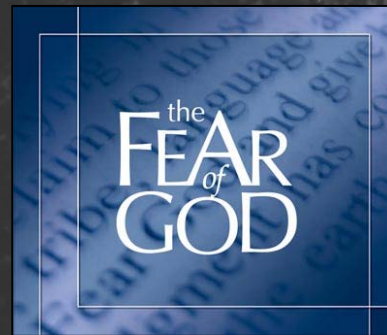
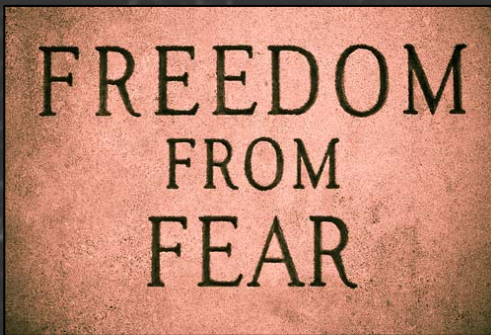
Review: ‘Nothing to fear’ and ‘freedom from fear.’ In Unsealing [#1908](#), it was discussed that Franklin D. Roosevelt was the ‘nothing to fear’ president in the Great Depression and the ‘freedom from fear’ president in World War II. Roosevelt’s words of encouragement concerning the Great Depression, “*the only thing we have to fear is fear itself,*” were spoken on March 4, 1933, in his first inaugural address, while “*freedom from fear*” was a part of his ‘Four Freedoms’ speech of January 6, 1941, and concerned World War II.

Key Understanding #1: *The ‘nothing to fear’ and ‘freedom from fear’ deaths. The March 2, 1933, death of Thomas Walsh was linked to the March 4, 1933, ‘nothing to fear’ first inauguration of Franklin D. Roosevelt, while the March 13, 1943, death of Stephen Vincent Benet was linked with Franklin D. Roosevelt’s ‘freedom from fear.’*





Key Understanding #2: The 'nothing to fear' and 'freedom from fear' deaths and Romans 11:20. Both the 'nothing to fear' death of Thomas Walsh and the 'freedom from fear' death of Stephen Vincent Benet represented the same warning from the Lord surrounding Romans 11:20-22.



Romans 11:20-22 (KJV) *Well; because of unbelief they [natural Jews, spoken of as Israel] were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, BUT FEAR:*
21 For if God spared not the natural branches [natural Jews, spoken of as Israel], take heed lest he also spare not thee.
*22 Behold therefore the goodness AND SEVERITY OF GOD [NIV . . . sternness of God]: ON THEM [natural Jews, spoken of as Israel] WHICH FELL, SEVERITY [fulfilled in part through the actions of the competing stern-faced king, Adolf Hitler and Nazi Germany, especially pointing to the event of Kristallnacht, November 9-10-11, 1938 (= 11:20,21,22), which marked a beginning to the Holocaust]; *but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: OTHERWISE THOU ALSO SHALT BE CUT OFF.**
