

**#1920** The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 179, *The Teapot Dome Scandal and the fall of Albert Fall: The Teapot Dome Oil Scandal, which points to the Pearl Harbor Oil Scandal, is reflective of the Church-ill with no oil*

**Key Understanding: “No oil with them.” The Teapot Dome oil scandal, the great prophetic purpose of which was to point to the Church-ill Pearl Harbor oil scandal, helps to explain why the Church-ill has “no oil with them.”**

*Matthew 25:1-13 (KJV) Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. 2 And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. 3 They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:*

*4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.*

*5 While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.*

*6 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.*

*7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps.*

*8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.*


*9 But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves.*

*10 And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.*


*11 Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us.*

*12 But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not.*

*13 Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.*
