

#1960 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 219, **The Assassination of John F. Kennedy, (xl), “The glow from the fire of defending freedom” leads to the eternal burning flame**

John F. Kennedy and the glow from the fire of defending freedom:

“In the long history of the world, only a few generations have been granted the role of defending freedom in its hour of maximum danger. I do not shrink from this responsibility—I welcome it. I do not believe that any of us would exchange places with any other people or any other generation. The energy, the faith, the devotion which we bring to this endeavor will light our country and all who serve it—and **the glow from that fire can truly light the world.** And so, my fellow Americans: ask not what your country can do for you—ask what you can do for your country. My fellow citizens of the world: ask not what America will do for you, but what together we can do for the freedom of man.” *John F. Kennedy, inaugural address, January 20, 1961*



**Review** (from the previous Unsealing): *Kennedy’s inauguration and death/burial are part of Daniel 7:11.* Both Kennedy’s January 20, 1961, inauguration speech and Kennedy’s November 22/25, 1963, slaying and burial are part of the fulfillment of Daniel 7:11.

*Daniel 7:11 (KJV) I beheld then because of **THE VOICE OF THE GREAT WORDS WHICH THE HORN SPAKE** [represented by John F. Kennedy’s inauguration speech of January 20, 1961]: **I BEHELD EVEN TILL THE BEAST WAS SLAIN** [warned about through the presaging event of the November 22, 1963, Oswald assassination of John F. Kennedy], **AND HIS BODY DESTROYED, AND GIVEN TO THE** [eternal] **BURNING FLAME** [warned about through the eternal flame placed on the gravesite of John F. Kennedy at his burial on November 25, 1963].*



**Key Understanding: *The fire and the flame.* The Lord ordained John F. Kennedy to speak the words “the glow from that fire [referring to the endeavor of defending freedom in the world] can truly light the world,” for those words are representative of “the great words which the horn spake” in Daniel 7:11 that lead to the Daniel 7:11 “burning flame.”**
