**Judgments at Nuremberg.** 12 defendants were sentenced to death by the International Military Tribunal in 1946: “**I**” = indicted; “**G**” = indicted and found guilty; “**O**” = Not Charged.

 <b>Martin Bormann</b>	I O G G	Death	<b>Deputy Fuhrer. Closest advisor to Hitler at the Fuhrer’s headquarters. Successor to Hess as Nazi Party Secretary.</b>  Sentenced to death in absentia, remains found in 1972.
 <b>Hans Frank</b>	I O G G	Death	<b>Governor-General of occupied Poland.</b>  Expressed repentance.  Hanged on October 16, 1946.
 <b>Wilhelm Frick</b>	I G G G	Death	<b>Hitler’s Minister of Internal Affairs (1933-1943) and Reich Protector of Bohemia-Moravia (1943-1945). Authored the Nuremberg Race Laws.</b>  Hanged on October 16, 1946.
 <b>Hermann Göring</b>	G G G G	Death	<b>Reich Marshal, Commander of the Luftwaffe (1935-1945), Chief of the 4-Year Plan (1936-1945). Created the Secret Police which developed into the Gestapo.</b>  Committed suicide the night before his execution.

	G G G G	Death	<p><b>Chief of the Operations Staff of the Armed Forces. Wilhelm Keitel's subordinate.</b></p> <p>Hanged on October 16, 1946.</p> <p>Subsequently exonerated by German court in 1953.</p>
 <p><b>Ernst Kaltenbrunner</b></p>	I O G G	Death	<p><b>Highest surviving SS-leader. Chief of RSHA (Reich Security Main Office) (1943-1945), the central Nazi intelligence organ. Also, commanded many of the Einsatzgruppen and several concentration camps.</b></p> <p>Hanged on October 16, 1946.</p>
 <p><b>Wilhelm Keitel</b></p>	G G G G	Death	<p><b>Chief of the High Command of the Armed Forces (Oberkommando der Wehrmacht) (1938-1945).</b></p> <p>Requested to be shot as a soldier. Request denied.</p> <p>Hanged on October 16, 1946.</p>
 <p><b>Joachim von Ribbentrop</b></p>	G G G G	Death	<p><b>Ambassador-Plenipotentiary (1935-1936). Ambassador to the United Kingdom (1936-1938). Nazi Foreign Minister (1938-1945).</b></p> <p>Hanged on October 16, 1946.</p>

 <b>Alfred Rosenberg</b>	G G G G	Death	<b>Party philosopher and racial theory ideologist. Later, Reich Minister of the Eastern Occupied Territories (1941-1945).</b>  Hanged on October 16, 1946.
 <b>Fritz Sauckel</b>	I I G G	Death	<b>Plenipotentiary of the Nazi slave labor program (1942-1945). He orchestrated the forced labor programs.</b>  Hanged on October 16, 1946.
 <b>Arthur Seyss-Inquart</b>	I G G G	Death	<b>Instrumental in the <i>Anschluss</i> (annexation of Austria into Greater Germany) and briefly Austrian Chancellor (1938). Deputy to Frank in Poland (1939-1940). Reich Commissioner of the occupied Netherlands (1940-1945).</b>  Expressed repentance.  Hanged on October 16, 1946.
 <b>Julius Streicher</b>	I O O G	Death	<b>Incited hatred and murder against the Jews through the weekly newspaper he founded in 1923, <i>Der Stürmer</i>.</b>  Hanged on October 16, 1946.

“I” = indicted; “G” = indicted and found guilty; “O” = Not Charged
