

#2159 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 418, **The Pale Horse, (xv), The Pale Horse arises in conjunction with the White Horse, the Red Horse, and the Black Horse: Review of Unsealing #807**



Key Understanding: *The Pale Horse arises in conjunction with the White Horse, the Red Horse, and the Black Horse. This segment of Unsealings is for the purpose of understanding that the Pale Horse and its rider arise in conjunction with the rise of the White Horse, the Red Horse, and the Black Horse. Reviews of Unsealings #785, #787–#789, #796–#799, #803, #806–#807, #812–#814, #819, and #821 will help to clarify. Below is a repeat of Unsealing #807. #807 The Black Horse Rider – Constantine the Great and York, England; Washington and Yorktown, Virginia; Wilson/Reagan and Sergeant York

This same theme was tackled in Unsealing #770 Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II – The Church with *The Spirit of '76*: Constantine and York and the spirit of Laodicea; Washington and Yorktown and the spirit of Laodicea. Now we are adding *Sergeant York* to the picture, attached to both Woodrow Wilson and Ronald Wilson Reagan.

Key Understanding: *York and Revelation 6:2. The Lord chose York to be closely connected to the war themes of the White Horse Rider in Revelation 6:2, for York is tied to the yew tree, the wood of which is used to make war bows.*

- (i) Constantine the Great and conquering through war were linked with York, England.
- (ii) George Washington and conquering through war were linked with Yorktown, Virginia.
- (iii) Woodrow Wilson and conquering through war were linked with Sergeant York, the man.
- (iv) Ronald Reagan and conquering through war were linked with Sergeant York, the horse.

Revelation 6:2 (KJV) And I saw, and behold A WHITE HORSE: and HE [Constantine the Great; George Washington; Woodrow Wilson; Ronald Reagan] THAT SAT ON HIM HAD A BOW [York; Yorktown; Sergeant York, the man; Sergeant York, the horse]; and A CROWN WAS GIVEN UNTO HIM: and HE WENT FORTH CONQUERING, AND TO CONQUER.
