

#2174 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 433, The Pale Horse, (xxx), Hitler as (i) the Daniel 8:23 competing Stern-faced King and (ii) a Revelation 6:7-8 Pale Horse Rider in the invasions of Poland and the former Pale of Settlement

The August 23, 1939, Nazi Germany-Soviet Union non-aggression pact. Hitler did not want war on two fronts. Negotiations began with the USSR that would result in the August 23, 1939,

Nazi-Soviet non-aggression pact (which Hitler would break with the German invasion of the Soviet Union in Operation Barbarossa on June 22, 1941). What this meant was that Hitler could invade Poland (which occurred nine days later on September 1, 1939) without Russian interference, and, in fact, actually established the specific plan for a forthcoming division of Poland with the USSR. The pact is also called the Ribbentrop-Molotov Pact, named after Soviet foreign minister Vyacheslav Molotov and German foreign minister Joachim von Ribbentrop.



Key Understanding: The August 23, 1939, Nazi-Soviet Pact fulfilled Daniel 8:23. The August

23, 1939, Nazi-Soviet Pact was a part of Adolf Hitler's/Nazi Germany's fulfillment of the competing stern-faced king of Daniel 8:23. It was this pact that opened the doors for Hitler/Nazi Germany to fulfill their role as a Pale Horse Rider.

Daniel 8:23 (NIV) "In THE LATTER PART OF THEIR REIGN, when rebels have become completely wicked, A STERN-FACED KING [a competing stern-faced king, represented by Adolf Hitler and Nazi Germany through the event of



*Kristallnacht, **November 9-10-11, 1938**, which can be considered a beginning to the Holocaust, and further fulfilled through the August 23 [= 8:23], 1939, Nazi-Soviet Pact that immediately led to Hitler's invasion of Poland and a fulfillment of the Pale Horse Rider, a master of intrigue, will arise.*
