THE PALE HORSE

*Revelation 6:7-8 (KJV) And when he had opened **THE FOURTH SEAL**, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.
8 And I looked, and behold A PALE HORSE: and his name that sat on him was DEATH, AND HELL followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.*

Key Understanding: *The fours of the pale horse and its rider. Before we continue on with the Pale Horse, it will help to see the strong emphasis on the number *four* that is associated with it.*

Below is a list of fours (4's) associated with the Pale Horse and its rider:

- 4 – The fourth seal** – “And when he had opened **THE FOURTH SEAL**,”
- 4 – The fourth beast** – “I heard the voice of **THE FOURTH BEAST** say,”
- 4 – The fourth horse** – The white, the red, the black, and then **THE PALE HORSE**.
- 4 – Four letters in the English word *pale*** – “And I looked, and behold **A PALE HORSE**.”
- 4 – The fourth part of the earth** – “And power was given unto them over **THE FOURTH PART** of the earth,”

4 – Killing in four ways – “to kill (i) with sword, and (ii) with hunger, and (iii) with death, and (iv) with the beasts of the earth.”
