

#2196 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 455, **The Pale Horse, (lii), The Pale Horse Rider Assassins: The Black Hand**

The Black Hand. A secret society called *Ujedinjenje ili Smrt* ('Union or Death') was founded in Belgrade, Serbia, in May 1911 as an outgrowth of an older Serb nationalist group, *Narodna Odbrana*. The Black Hand took over the older group's work of anti-Austrian propaganda within Serbia, espionage, and political murders abroad – especially in provinces Serbia wished to annex. The group included many government officials, professionals, and army officers. When it was learned that the heir apparent to the Austrian throne, Franz Ferdinand, was scheduled to visit Sarajevo in June of 1914, the Black Hand decided to assassinate him. Three young Bosnian Serbs were recruited, trained, and equipped – **Gavrilo Princip**, **Nedjelko Cabrinovic**, and **Trifko Grabez**.

Preparations for the assassination. Princip, Grabez, and Cabrinovic secretly made their way back (from Serbia) to Sarajevo roughly a month before Franz Ferdinand made his way to Sarajevo. A fourth man, Danilo Ilic, had joined the group, and on his own initiative recruited three others. Vaso Cubrilovic and Cvijetko Popovic were 17-year-old high school students. Muhamed Mehmedbasic, a Bosnian Muslim, was added to give the group a less pan-Serb appearance. Four Serbian army pistols and six bombs were supplied from Serbian army arsenals.

Key Understanding: The assassination of the pale horse rider. It was the June 28, 1914, assassination in Sarajevo, Bosnia, of the Archduke of Austria, heir apparent to the throne

of the Austrian Empire and nephew of ‘Pale Horse Rider’ Austrian Emperor Franz Joseph (who would rule the Austrian Empire exactly 68 years), that led to the outbreak of World War I. Furthermore, the event of World War I ended the Austrian Empire. The assassination that sparked World War I led to the death of the ‘Pale Horse Rider’ Austrian Empire.
