

#2228 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 487, **The Pale Horse, (lxxxiv), The Great Whore sitting on many waters, and America sitting on the Seven Seas**

Key Understanding #1: The first Babylon and the *second* Babylon – Babylon the Great – sit on many waters. This is seen in Jeremiah 51:13, Revelation 17:1, and Revelation 17:15.

Jeremiah 51:7-14 (KJV) Babylon hath been a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

8 Babylon is suddenly fallen and destroyed: howl for her; take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed.

9 We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up even to the skies.

10 The LORD hath brought forth our righteousness: come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD our God.

11 Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device is against Babylon, to destroy it; because it is the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple.

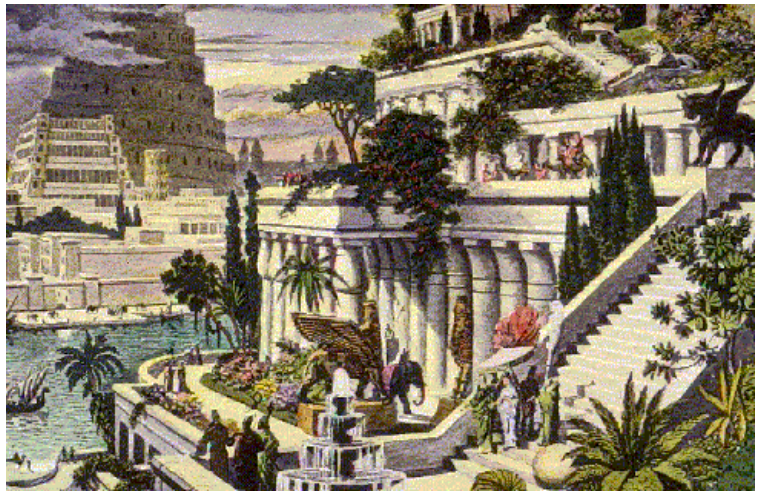
12 Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.

*13 **O THOU THAT DWELLEST UPON MANY WATERS,** abundant in treasures, thine end is come, and the measure of thy covetousness.*

14 The LORD of hosts hath sworn by himself, saying, Surely I will fill thee with men, as with caterpillers; and they shall lift up a shout against thee.

Revelation 17:1 (KJV) And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I WILL SHEW UNTO THEE THE JUDGMENT OF THE GREAT WHORE THAT SITTETH UPON MANY WATERS:

Babylon the Great sitting on the Seven Seas. The seven spikes in the crown of the Statue of Liberty (right) represent the seven seas and seven continents. Today, the Seven Seas



refer(s) to the North Pacific Ocean, the South Pacific Ocean, the North Atlantic Ocean, the South Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Antarctic Ocean, and the Arctic Ocean. In medieval European literature, however, the Seven Seas referred to any seven of the following eleven bodies of water: the Adriatic Sea, the Aegean Sea, the Arabian Sea, the Black Sea, the Caspian Sea, the Indian Ocean, the Irish Sea, the Mediterranean Sea, the North Sea, the Persian Gulf, and the Red Sea. In general, the term *Seven Seas* is used as a term for the seas of the world, or for “several” seas.

Key Understanding #2: *The great whore sitting on many waters, and America sitting on the seven seas.* The Lord ordained the Statue of Liberty to be represented as sitting on seven seas and seven continents to further reveal America to be Babylon the Great, *sitting upon many waters.* The sitting upon many waters is fulfilled literally through America sitting upon many waters, including the Atlantic Ocean, the Pacific Ocean, the Gulf of Mexico, the Great Lakes, the Mississippi River, the Potomac River, etc., as well as the literal fulfillment of the symbolic meaning attached to “waters” explained in Revelation 17:15 (below).

Revelation 17:15 (KJV) And he saith unto me, THE WATERS WHICH THOU SAWEST, WHERE THE WHORE SITTETH, ARE PEOPLES, AND MULTITUDES, AND NATIONS, AND TONGUES.
