

#2229 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 488, **The Pale Horse, (lxxxv), Like the Rich Man, the Lazarus nation is clothed in purple and fine linen**

The rich man was clothed in purple and fine linen

Luke 16:19-25 (KJV) There was A CERTAIN RICH MAN, WHICH WAS CLOTHED IN PURPLE AND FINE LINEN, and fared sumptuously every day:

20 And there was a certain beggar named LAZARUS, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from THE RICH MAN'S TABLE: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

22 And it came to pass, that THE BEGGAR [Lazarus] DIED, and was carried by the angels into ABRAHAM'S BOSOM: THE RICH MAN ALSO DIED, and was buried;

23 And IN HELL he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and LAZARUS IN HIS [Abraham's] BOSOM.
24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I AM TORMENTED IN THIS FLAME.

25 But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.



Babylon the Great is clothed in fine linen and purple

Revelation 18:16-18 (KJV) And saying, Alas, alas, THAT GREAT CITY [Babylon the Great], THAT WAS CLOTHED IN FINE LINEN, AND PURPLE, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

17 For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city!

Key Understanding #1: America is clothed like the rich man. Like the rich man, the 'give me your tired, your poor' Lazarus nation of America is clothed in fine linen, and purple, indicating that it is actually – in the eyes of the Lord – to be likened to the rich man who was dwelling in

hell, and not likened to poor Lazarus, who was dwelling in paradise.

Key Understanding #2: *America is clothed like paradise, but leads to hell.* Obviously, America is not considered by the Lord to be a paradise for his people, but, rather, is considered by the Lord to be an offering from Satan (Matthew 4:8-9) which eventually leads to hell those who have sought an earthly kingdom (that counterfeits the Lord's heavenly kingdom) more than they have sought the Lord's heavenly kingdom.
