

**#2244** The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 503, **The Pale Horse, (c), A Pale Horse at the start of World War I, a Pale Horse at the entry of the U.S. into World War I, and a Pale Horse to start World War II**

**Key Understanding:** *Pale horses at the beginnings of three events.* There were Pale Horses (i) *at the start of World War I, through the June 28, 1914, ‘Pale’ assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand,* (ii) *at the U.S. entry into World War I, through the April 2, 1917, ‘Make the World Safe for Democracy’ intentions of Woodrow Wilson and the April 2, 1917, end of the Pale of Settlement by Kerensky’s democratic Provisional Government, and (iii) at the start of World War II, through the agreement between Hitler’s Germany and Stalin’s USSR toward a Fourth Partition of Poland.*

(i) June 28, 1914  
Pale Horse to start World War I

The ‘Pale’ assassination  
of Austrian Archduke  
Franz Ferdinand



(ii) April 2, 1917  
Pale Horse at the U.S. entry into World War I

America exercising its role as the Pale  
Horse Rider, in the form of declaring  
war and defeating the Prussian  
(German) Empire



**Revelation 6:8 (KJV) And I looked, and behold A PALE HORSE: and his name that sat on him was DEATH, AND HELL followed with him. And power was given unto them over THE FOURTH PART OF THE EARTH, to kill (i) with sword, and (ii) with hunger, and (iii) with death, and (iv) with the beasts of the earth.**

(ii) April 2, 1917  
Pale Horse *at the U.S. entry* into World War I

Alexander Kerensky's democratic  
Provisional Government – which  
prophetically represents the United States of  
America – ends the Russian Pale of  
Settlement



(iii) August 23-September 1, 1939  
Pale Horse *at the start* of World War II

The *second* Fourth Partition of Poland was a  
result of the August 23, 1939, Nazi-Soviet  
Pact (Ribbentrop-Molotov Pact) in which  
Germany and the Soviets agreed to divide  
Poland between themselves once more. It  
immediately led to the start of World War II.
