**Key Understanding (of Unsealing #2197): *The city of Pale.*** At this point in time, the city of Pale, a mountain town about 12 miles east of Sarajevo, enters into the prophetic story of the assassination of Archduke Francis Ferdinand, because he was representing the Austrian-Hungarian Empire, along with Emperor Franz Joseph, as a Revelation 6:7-8 Pale Horse Rider. The town is pronounced *PAH-leh*, but spelled like the English word *pale*. [See the picture on page 2 below of a panoramic view of Pale today.]

***Revelation 6:8 (KJV) And I looked, and behold A PALE HORSE: and his name that sat on him was DEATH, AND HELL followed with him. And power was given unto them over THE FOURTH PART OF THE EARTH, to kill (i) with sword, and (ii) with hunger, and (iii) with death, and (iv) with the beasts of the earth.***






**More than any other president in U.S. history, Bill Clinton played a large role in the Balkans in the 1990's, for the purpose of fulfilling his role as a Pale Horse Rider.**



Panoramic view of Pale today. In the 1990's, after the break-up of the nation of Yugoslavia, wars encompassed the region. Pale became the subject of international attention because it was the capital of the Serb Republic that was formed within Bosnia and Herzegovina. Serbs separated from Croatian and Muslim enclaves and declared their own republic in the spring of 1992 with the ostensible purpose of fulfilling the historical dream of linking with the Serbian dominated rump of Yugoslavia to create a Greater Serbia, similar to the hopes of Serbians before World War I.
