The 1999 Kosovo War. The Kosovo War was a war between Serbia (Yugoslavia) and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) in the time period from March 24 to June 10, 1999, during which (an American-led) NATO attacked Serbian targets. The war against Serbia was billed as a humanitarian attempt by NATO to impair and reverse Slobodan Milosevic’s ethnic cleansing of Albanians in Kosovo.

Key Understanding: ‘Pale’ Reagan-Bush to ‘Pale’ Clinton. Extending the theme provided by Pale, Bosnia, to the 1999 Kosovo War, the Reagan-Bush December 8-10, 1991, ‘Pale Horse’ Cold War defeat of the Soviet Union led to the Clinton-NATO ‘Pale Horse’ defeat of the Serbs in the 1999 Kosovo War.

Step 1 – Reagan/Bush were Pale Horse Riders, ending the Soviet Union (in the Pale at Minsk, Belarus) on December 8-10, 1991

Former Yugoslavia

In 1997, a civil war between Kosovo and Serbia broke out over Kosovo's independence. The Serbs, led by Slobodan Milosevic, had decided on a campaign of ethnic cleansing to rid Kosovo of all Albanian Muslims. By 1998, the U.S. and NATO stepped in to stop the genocide. This may have been the first time any nation had intervened to stop ethnic cleansing and succeeded. The intervention by the U.S. prevented additional killing, but ethnic tensions still remained between Kosovars and Serbs.
