

#2338 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 597, **Hebron Massacre of August 23-24, 1929, (xx), The theme of doubles surrounding the *second* Hebron Massacre, where 29 were killed, and the *first* Hebron Massacre, which occurred in ‘29**

*2 Kings 2:9 (KJV) And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let **A DOUBLE PORTION OF THY SPIRIT** be upon me.*

Key Understanding #1: The double Hebron massacres and 29. The number 29 is used extensively by the Lord to denote a “double portion of the spirit,” as has been discussed several times before (including in Unsealings #159 and #1177). Such is also the case with the two Hebron Massacres, for the *first* Hebron Massacre occurred in ‘29 (Jews were killed by Arabs), and in the *second* Hebron Massacre, 29 were killed (Arabs were killed by a Jew). In fact, 29 were killed in the *second* Hebron Massacre for the very purpose of linking it with the Hebron Massacre in ‘29.

Key Understanding #2: The double Hebron massacres and the September 13, 1993, Oslo Accord covenant. The *first* Hebron Massacre of ‘29 and the *second* Hebron Massacre in which 29 were killed also had the common denominator of being linked to the September 13, 1993, Oslo Accord covenant between Yithzak Rabin and Yassir Arafat. The *first* Hebron Massacre of August 24, 1929, was linked to the September 13, 1993, Rabin-Arafat covenant because Arafat was born on August 24, 1929, the same day as the massacre. The *second* Hebron Massacre of February 25, 1994, was linked to the September 13, 1993,

accord because the question on the world's mind upon its occurrence was the impact that it would have upon the "peace process".
